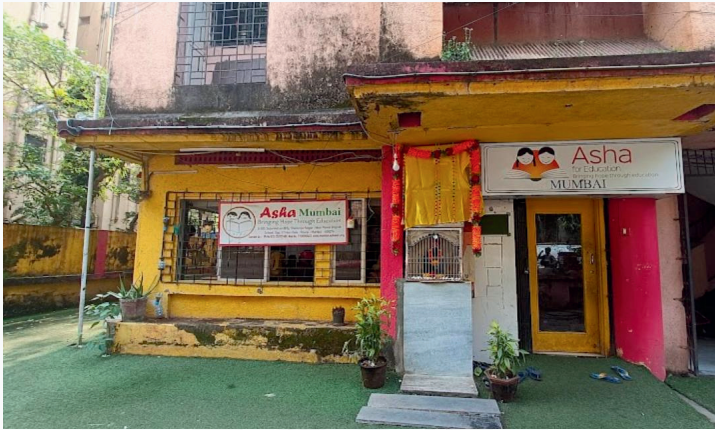

ABOUT ASHA MAIN CENTER




Asha for Education, Mumbai Chapter, established in 2006, is dedicated to providing quality education to marginalized sections of society.

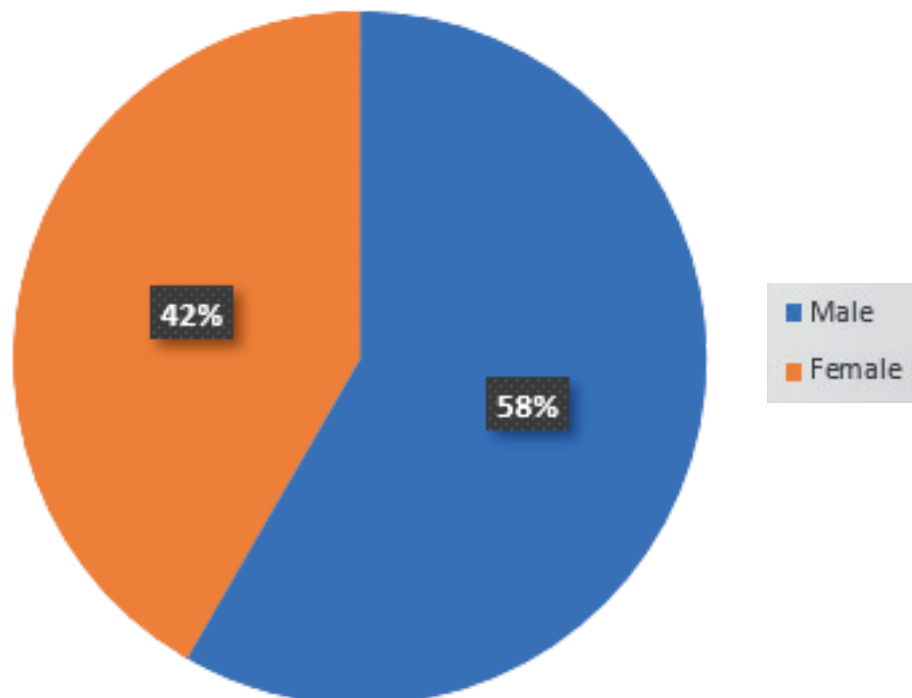

ACADEMICS



- **Regular Classes**

Regular classes for Primary, Secondary, and Higher Secondary sections were conducted throughout the year to ensure continuous learning and academic support.

- **Primary Section**

Primary section classes were held from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m., with a focus on Reading, Writing, and Arithmetic through interactive and hands-on learning methods instead of rote memorization. Each session began with a prayer to support the spiritual growth of young learners, following the philosophy of “Catch them young.

Saturdays were reserved for sports and outdoor activities to encourage physical development and teamwork among students. This year, workbooks, dictionaries, and diaries were also introduced

for every student to promote daily journaling, improve vocabulary, and strengthen writing skills.





• Secondary Section

Our academic schedule is designed for effective learning and overall student development. Core subjects like Languages, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies are taught in a comprehensive manner throughout the year.

Special support classes are conducted from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m. for students facing learning difficulties to help them improve their performance.

Students are also given workbooks with creative and challenging exercises to develop critical thinking and practical understanding.

The Secondary Section runs from 2 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., and students are expected to bring their textbooks and notebooks regularly.

• Higher Secondary

At the Higher Secondary level, Commerce classes are held in the morning and Science classes in the evening for better focus.

The Class 12 syllabus is completed by November, followed by regular

tests and practical exams to prepare students for Board Examinations.



Similarly, Class 10 students undergo regular assessments throughout the year for better preparation.

At the +2 level, examinations are more significant as they play an important role in shaping students' future careers.

- **Computer Lab**

With the rapid advancement of technology, our Computer Lab continues to evolve to meet the learning needs of students.



This year, the computer lab has been upgraded with 30 systems, including laptops, desktops, and all-in-one desktops. This expansion has enabled us to introduce programming at all levels, ranging from Scratch for younger students to Java for senior students.

Our goal is to equip students with computer proficiency, empowering them to navigate the increasingly digitized world with ease. From online banking and ticket booking to online shopping and cloud storage, our curriculum ensures students can handle these processes seamlessly.



Additionally, we conduct three-month basic computer courses for non-Asha students, helping the local community become tech-savvy and offering them an opportunity to integrate into the digital age.

- **Science Lab**

Our well-equipped Science Lab supports all three branches of science—Physics, Chemistry, and Biology—and is utilized by +2 level students and teachers, with valuable assistance from NSS student volunteers from IIT Bombay.

Through hands-on activities and experiments, students gain practical knowledge by creating room blueprints, exploring the presence of air, constructing working models such as the Dialysis and Digestive Systems, and testing the acidity or basicity of common liquids. The lab's compound microscopes further enable students to study cell structures in leaves, flowers, and blood, as well as the stages of mitosis and meiosis.



- **Library**

The library serves as a vital learning resource, fostering knowledge, curiosity, and lifelong learning among students and teachers.



At Asha, our library houses a diverse collection of books across all subjects, including storybooks, encyclopedias, journals on environmental issues, periodicals, and dictionaries. Both teachers and students extensively utilize these resources to enrich their learning, expand their knowledge, and broaden their perspectives in an age of abundant information.

- **Sai Bangoda Education Initiative**

Asha Mumbai's commitment to extending educational opportunities reached Sai Bangoda, an Adivasi village in Powai, eight years ago

through the introduction of preschool classes in a community that previously lacked educational facilities. The village, with around 200 households and BMC schools located on its outskirts, faced challenges in providing accessible education for young children.

To address this need, Asha Mumbai now provides supplementary education to 35–40 students from Std. 1–7 through village teachers who receive regular training at Asha's main center on weekends.

In addition, students are supported with uniforms, stationery, and nutritional assistance. This sustained effort has transformed education in Sai Bangoda into a success story, bringing meaningful learning opportunities to a previously underserved community.

- **Asha Mumbai – Wardha Initiative**

educational and career opportunities while fostering a love for reading and lifelong learning.

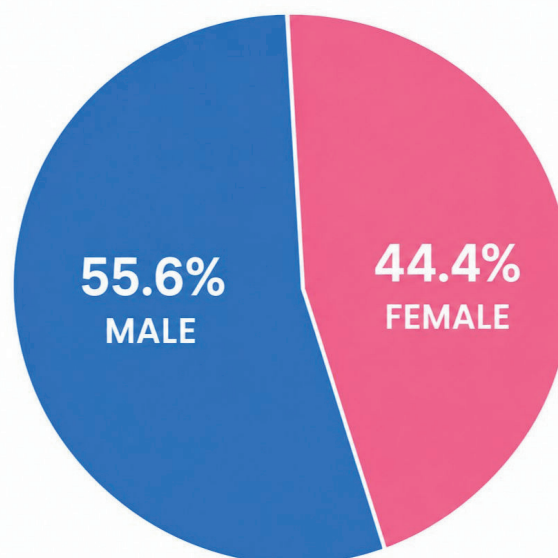

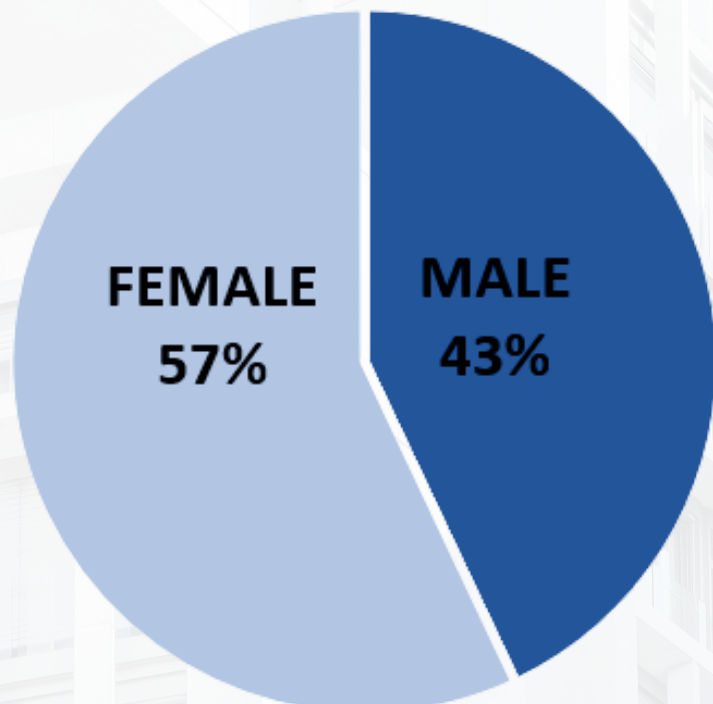

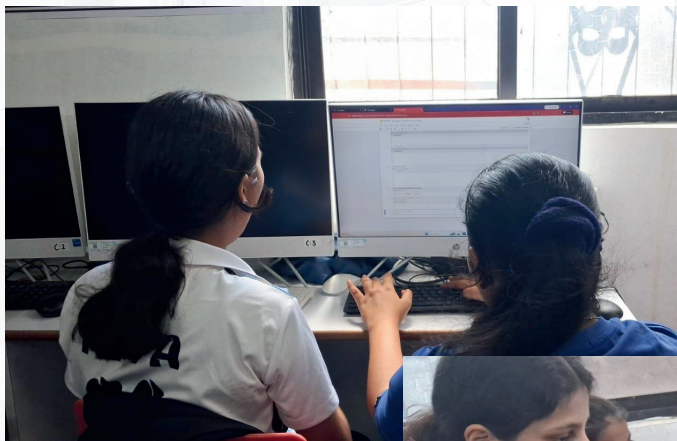
- **Handbag-Making Course Initiative**

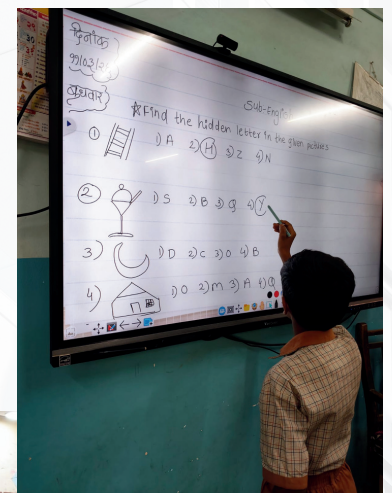


B.M.C School PROJECT

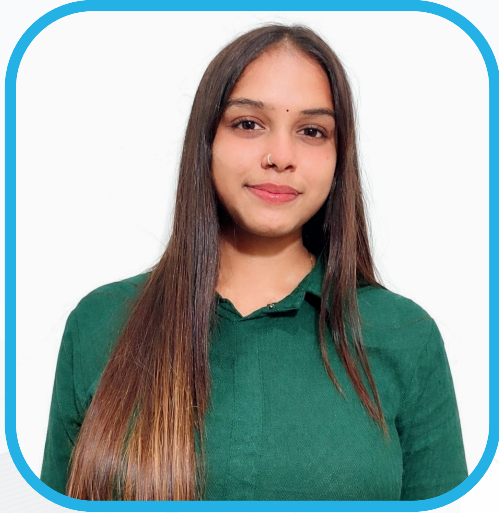

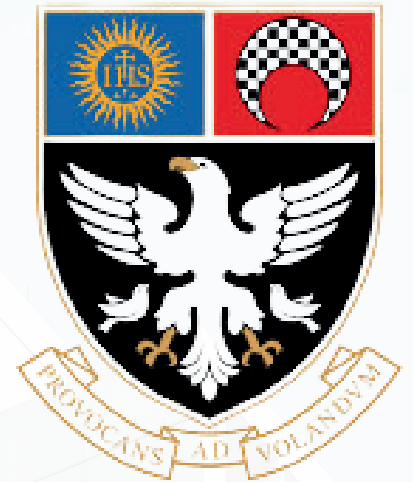
