Volunteer onboarding

- Volunteer orientation by Bhumi and volunteering at Shelter Homes



Baseline Assessment

- Assessment conducted to infer current level of knowledge in Maths, English and Digital Literacy.



Supplementary Education and mentoring

- Trained Volunteers take sessions on various subjects like Maths, English, Digital Literacy, arts and crafts.



Talent activities

- Annual sports and talent event held across Shelter Homes, giving children opportunity to showcase their talent and greater exposure



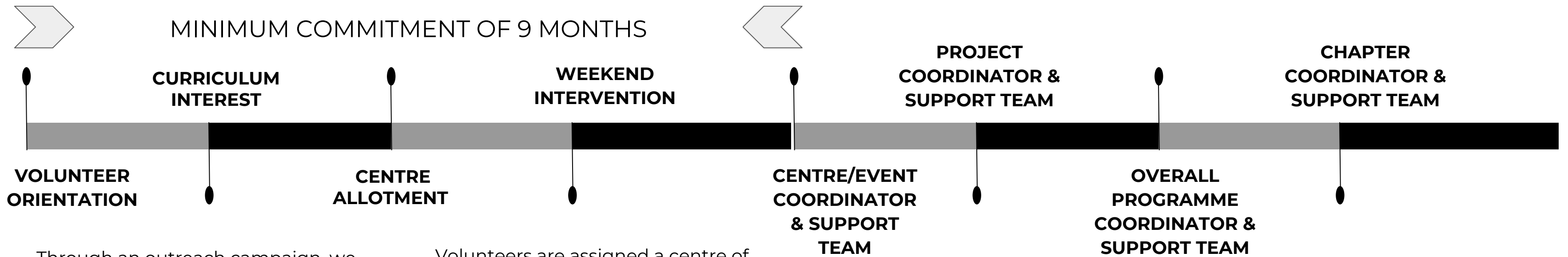
Endline Assessment

- Assessments conducted at completion is used to measure shift in learning levels and program success.

Journey Of A Volunteer

2 After the orientation, volunteers are given an introduction to pedagogy, and modules for a course of their choice are shared with them. They are supported with lesson planning and execution.

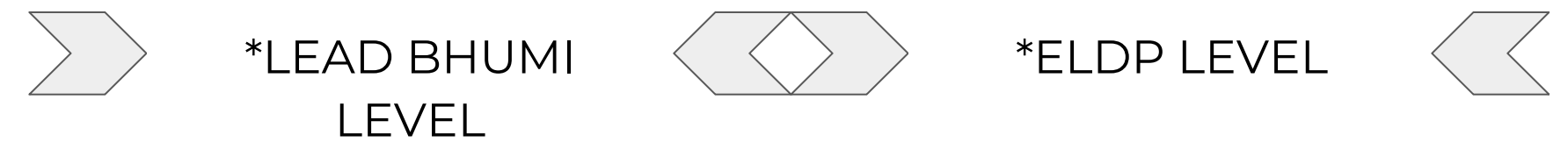
4 Volunteers who wish to contribute more are given the opportunity to lead projects at the city/national level



1 Through an outreach campaign, we invite volunteers to sign up to teach in our Shelter Homes program. The registrants attend an orientation session.

Volunteers are assigned a centre of their choice, where they can start teaching on weekends. They have the option to teach online if a center of their choice is not available.

Our curriculum for shelter homes is aligned with National Curriculum Framework and NCERT.

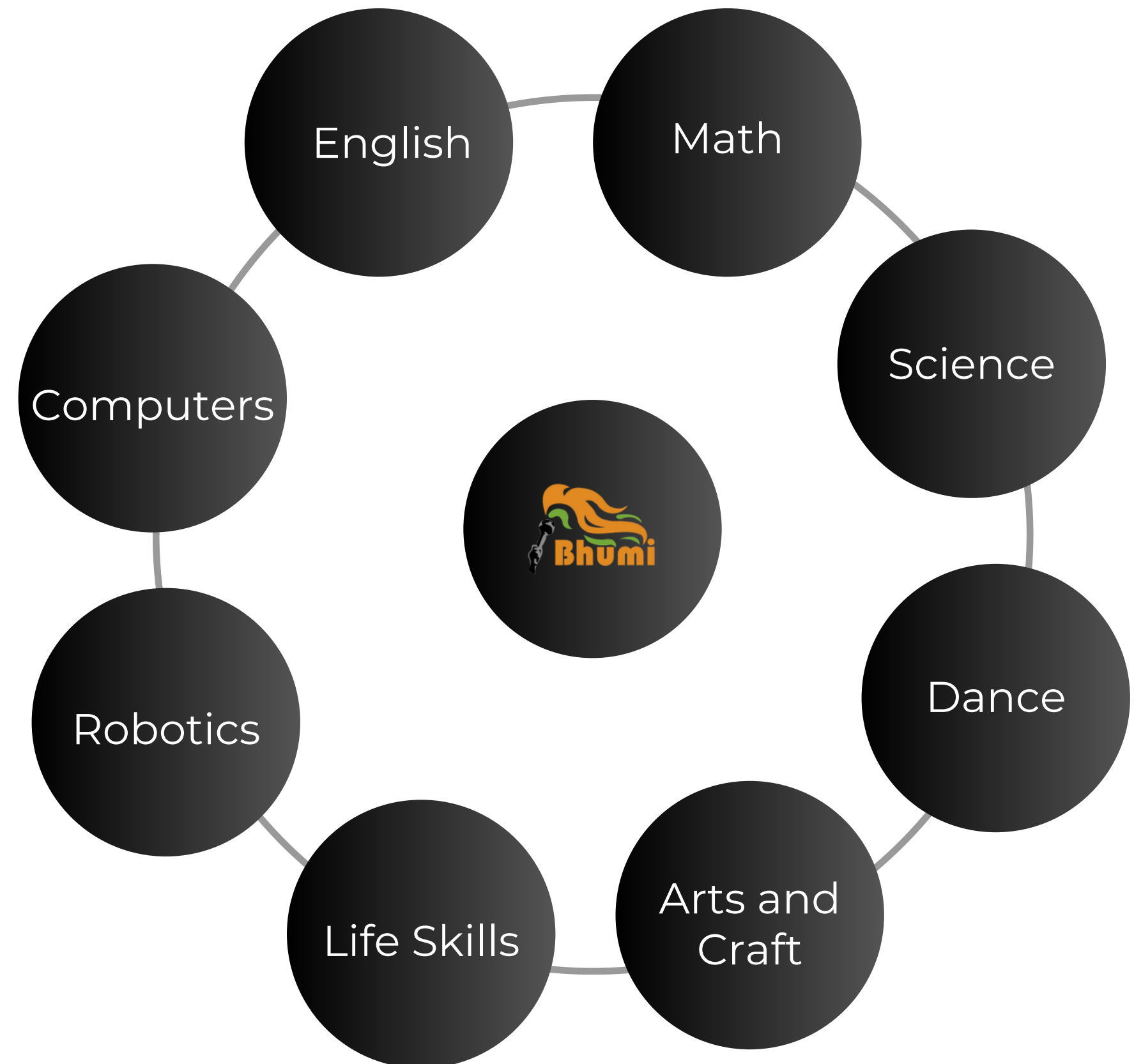

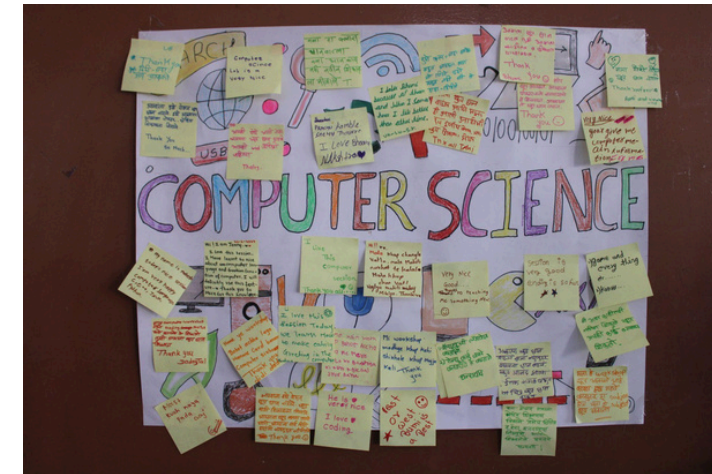

NAKSHATRA



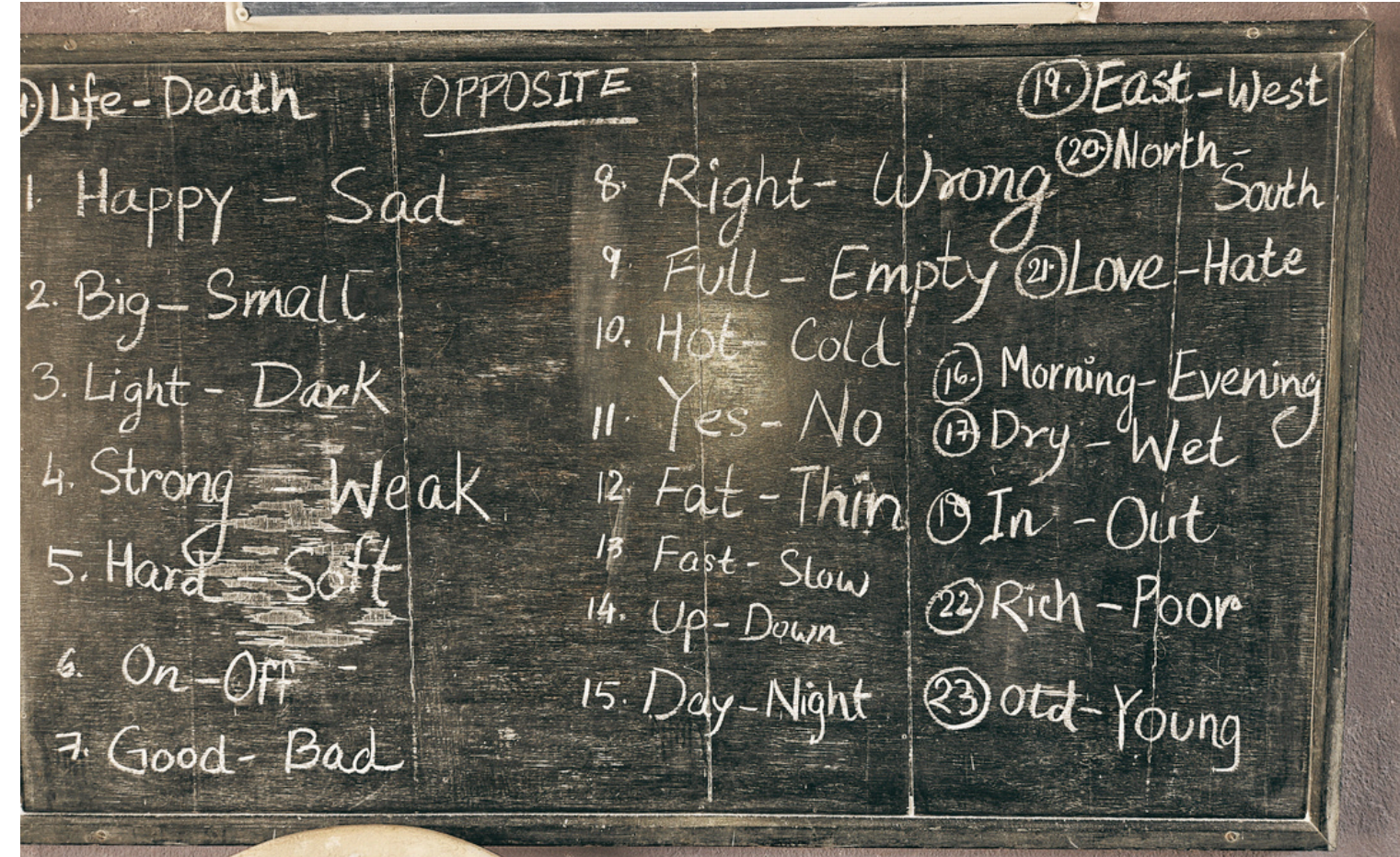
