

Mansa Site Visit – July 2012

They told her that the building had four floors of which only the second and third floors seemed to be ready by the end of July. The first floor and parking lot were still unfinished. They also stated that the absence of walls for first floor wasn't very safe for the children. Also they visited the two rooms that were rented out Manasa for the next two months before the school could reopen. The children were active and having the same classes as before but the current rented rooms seemed very congested, so the faster they shift to their new building the better it would be for the children.
