## Working In Karumbalai

There are 3 children education centres, and1 young people education centre that are functioning every evening 6 pm to 9 pm from Monday to Saturday. Some other extracurricular activities are conducted during Sundays too.

In the year 2022-2023, **225 children have registered** at Madurai Seed from 5 years to 17 years. 115 boys + 107 Girls

Among **120 children are coming to centres regularly**. 65 boys + 55 girls. According to our room spaces, this is a maximum capacity we can hold.

15 children are going to write 10th std board exam

10 are going to write 11th board exam

15 are going to write  $12^{th}$  board exam

In these 35 children in 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> 57% are first generation in their families to finish this level of education.

**17 young people** are volunteering at Madurai Seed, among 15 are studying in colleges. 2 volunteers who have finished under graduation are now preparing for government and bank exams.

Among 17 college goers, 12 are women and 3 are men. 9 are first graduates.

Children are having evening classes from Monday to Saturday from 6pm to 9pm.

- I am taking care of the overall management of evening classes.
- Also, I have planned and conducted various **extracurricular activities** during special occasions and holidays.
- We organized many group reading sessions with the help of volunteers, books, and projector
- I planned them to participate in other organization's events, public events, and other educational and cultural programs.
- Guidance and counselling is provided to needful children and young people in terms of educational choice, vocational choice, family problems, and difficult situations.
- Conducted summer camp for 16 days in the month of May 2022, after two years Covid gap.

## **Working with Sevalayam Hostel:**

This hostel for boys aged from 10 to 17 years is run by Tamilnadu Harijan Seva Sangh, and has a long history and tradition. Currently, **78 students** are staying here and studying in a nearby government school. Madurai Seed works hand in hand with this hostel in the previous years also. During Covid and After around 2 years, we haven't been in touch with them.

In this year 2022-23, we have done more programs for them.

- One of our volunteers is teaching Maths to the 10<sup>th</sup> std students here on Sundays
- Madurai Seed has sponsored Audio/Sound systems to the newly built hall in the hostel.
- On **children's day**, we organized three resource persons to conduct three different programs
- Took part in **Pongal** celebration at Sevalayam
- Conducted reading session and provided the small book on freedom fighter V.O.Chidambaram to all children
- Conducted song-singing session by Vidya, an NRI volunteer.
- Madurai Seed's alumni meet and Diwali program was conducted in Sevalayam premises.



### **Working with Interns/ Students:**

People are coming to learn from me, and Madurai Seed.

- 12 students from English Department. Thiagarajar College, Madurai
  have approached for internship at Madurai Seed. We designed it as a
  learning internship for students. For 15 days, various resource persons
  came directly and through online to teach, guide the students in many
  areas related to their studies, interests, teaching, and skills and
  personality development.
- 10 students from Sociology Department, Lady Doak College came to learn about NGOs, community development, problems in Karumbalai, etc. We assisted them for a field study and project, conversations with children and young people.
- 1 research scholar from BITS Pilani, Hyderabad came for inputs regarding water management, community participation, and government roles in providing water, protecting water bodies etc. She interviewed me for nearly 5 hours regarding my experience with working with the locals, Madurai's water resources, water scarcity etc.
- 10 primary school students from Kodai International School has come for a field study. They wanted to learn about the locality, children's lifestyle, and education. It was kind of cultutal exchange program. They learnt from seed children, our children learnt from them.
- 5 students from Madurai Agriculture College came to learn about organizational aspects as a part of their rural sociology studies.



# **Working with Volunteers:**

People are coming from Madurai, around India, and abroad are coming to volunteer, teach classes, share skills etc.

- Vidya, an NRI from Netherlands taught singing/song classes. She learns
   Carnatic music from childhood.
- Krithika, a home-schooled student from Chennai organized a drawing session for kids. She is an artist.
- Miruthula, a school student from Australia came and talked about reading, story writing for teenage children.
- Murugesan, and Viji our local friends and supporters have come during many occasions, and being an inspiration for our students.
- Keith, an abroad volunteer from Switzerland who is an English lecturer taught classes for our children and young people. He conducted cover letter and resume writing workshop for college students.
- Katrin and Urs, from Switzerland taught classes for children from 7<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> std.
- John Potts, from Switzerland who is one of our main supporters taught classes from 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> students and college volunteers about interview skills and general language practice. He also conducted an workshop on interview skills.



# **Working with Resource Persons**

I have been linking resource persons with children and young people in possible occasions. Resource persons from various walks of life and profession came directly and through online throughout the year. If you see the list, and their profile they are the great role models and inspiration. There are lots of things to learn from them.

# Working with Taj Amma

Ever since, Dr.Taj (88 years old), has returned to stay in Madurai, I am
working closely with her. She is one of the pioneer doctors, social workers
in Madurai. She contacts whenever she needs to provide something to
the poor, homeless, disadvantaged students, government schools like
cloths, food, books, stationaries etc.

### Working with Kaleidoscope:

 It is a centre for alternative arts, culture, and education run by my professor Prabakar for young people, teachers, social workers, and artists. The building of rooftop, and some equipment were sponsored by Madurai Seed. Whenever possible, Madurai Seed children and youth are using this space for our programs. I have worked to organize some programs with Prof.Prabakar for college students of Madurai.

## **Working for Housing Assistance:**

In March 2022, Infoview an IT company based in Chennai has offered a CSR fund to Madurai Seed to do community development activities in Karumbalai. I have identified there are lack of awareness, misguidance and financial problem in getting plot approval documentation from Tamilnadu Urban Habitat Development Board (TNUHDB).

I have given **moral support and guidance** to **3 families** to get documentation for their plots. **3 families** were given **financial assistance** to get their plots registered.

8 families have applied for **269 Sq.Ft house in TNUHDB apartment** scheme at Rajakoor which is 12 kms away from Karumbalai. Among **4 people** got their house. Financial assistance was given by Madurai Seed.

Housing and its documentation are a major need for Karumbalai people. In many cases lack of this awareness leads to other problems, insecurities and disputes. In the year 2022-23, 10 families have benefited from this community work.

# Conclusion

From the age of 14, I have been in the service field through various schemes, organizations, people like Arivoli Iyakkam, Uruthunai, Dr. Taj, NSS program of American College, Dr. Adams, Seed Education Centres, Madurai Seed Narpanigal, etc.

I have grown Madurai Seed Narpanigal into a successful organization from its reestablishment in 2007 as a registered organization. It is a great grassroot model. Children growing up as volunteers, and teaching the children from their same locale. Lots of children and young people found hope through education.
