Me and my younger son Ajay Raman visited Annambedu shelter home for disabled kids. We were welcomed by Mrs. Nagarani (Founder and Managing Trustee) and were given a tour of the campus by a hope staff. The last time I visited this place about two years ago, it was under construction. It was amazing to see the way the facility was built, with great attention to details to provide the best care possible for these children.

There were around 40 children at the time I visited. I met with all the staff members.
