# Organization overview

Digambarpur Angikar is a 20 year old organization in the Sundarban region, aimed at

- pre-primary and primary education of children and
- empowerment of women and children

belonging to the socio-economically backward communities in the region.

Asha has been supporting the organization since 2014, to run 3 pre-primary schools in the region.

In 2017 we provided additional funding to provide vocational training to girls with special needs.



## **Project Proposal for Rehabilitation:**

Construction of concrete roof, replacing damaged Tin shaded roof of the existing Kitchen and dining room of preprimary education Centre at Canning and Ghutiary Shariff.

## **Present Challenge faced:**

On 20th May, 2020 super cyclone 'Amphan' devastated the entire life and livelihood of the people living in Sundarban delta region under North and South 24 Parganas District of West Bengal. The cyclone devastated the entire Sundarban region and more than 15 million people are affected and a million of kachha houses are damaged or destroyed including our tin shaded roof of pre-primary kitchen and dining room.

## **Estimated Budget:**

**Canning Centre:** 1000 sq ft x 500 per sq ft = Rs. 500000

**Ghutiary Shariff Centre:** 1000 sq ft x 500 per sq ft = Rs. 500000

Total Grant Requested: Rs.10, 00,000 (Ten lakhs only)

Asha Central Budget for each project : 15 lakhs total

Had a discussion with Asha Cornell ( The Cornell chapter was requested INR 8,75,000 for construction of crèche school roof)

**So we decided to fund INR 6,25,000 From Asha SF Chapter.**
