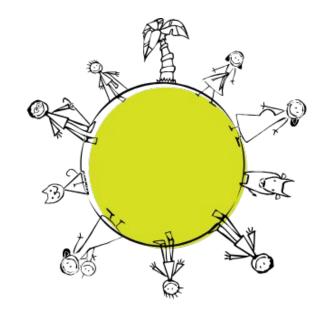
tihar project proposal 2019-2020



SAMARPAN FOUNDATION

- A non profit in Delhi who works to provide global support and assistance where there is humanitarian welfare needed.
- Currently has 8 schools in Delhi which are reaching the poorest sections of society hoping to educate children and bring families out of poverty.
- We support those 8 schools alongside Tihar Jail's program -Injustice of Justice, which works to bring justice to prison inmates and their families

in summation,

We have located the families of inmates, paid their house rent, put the children in school, provided dry rations and offered training to the wives so that they can be independent.

Programs for Prisoners

- Weekly counselling and healing for inmates is offered.
- Psychological and specialised medical care, such as eye clinics, are arranged.
- Talent spotting competitions and an annual inter-jail quiz are held.
- Assignments, such as painting, are given to provide a source of income.
- Skills development programmes are provided to empower inmates to earn an income after release.

Programs for Families

- Volunteers create surrogate family and provide a support ex. nutritional, medical, financial, educational and emotional structure.
- Families are moved towards independence, particularly financial
- Education and vocational training enabled self-sustenance + confidence to feed family
 - Children have improved education and extracurricular activities.
 - Individualized needs are responded to; for example, by providing sewing machines as a potential source of income as well as clothing and household items.
- Functions are organized and festivals and special events are celebrated with the families.
