

Mathru foundation Review (2nd half of 2020)

Summary (new updates in Blue)

- Schools not open for the entire review period (April – September)
- Plan to open undergrad and above in November. [Just opened in the second week of November. 3 of Mathru students can go to college but are preferring to stay in their home. Foundation not started. Trust decided to wait for vaccines. One of them has asthma; so not risking kids going to school/college].
- Fund-utilization is primarily staff salary with very minimal utility expenses.
- Fundraising: None this year
- Malathiji talking to kids/parents: Online learning since 9th grade for kids. She pays for the kids phone bills due to the online learning.
- Audit report expected in first week of November at which time we can re-visit unanswered questions and review the audit utilization. [Just received the unsigned copy of it. Sharing it with the group].

Questions?

- How much money raised through Milaap?

Roughly 60-70k couple of years back. It was just a one time event.

- Provide online physio-therapy suggestion?

None of these are provided right now.

- Who are in private/public schools and who are studying online (from 9th grade). What about studying in govt. schools? Also 7th and 10th board exams? [Chandana channel in TV is used for learning for govt.schools from 7th grade onwards].
- How much recurring donations is Mathru still receiving? Budget indicated 17000 per month. [Confirmed with Malathiji that this amount is still the same].
- Any medical emergencies or needs? How is that handled? [Primarily surgeries. So, no medical expenses right now. When they come back next year, things like calipers need to be re-examined and seen if they need some fixes/re-done].
