## **Section 2 - Proposed Program Details**

Asha is working with remote rural schools in the following districts of Tamilnadu: Thiruvallur, Kanchipuram, Villupuram, Thiruvannamalai, Thoothukudi Thirunelveli. We support about 100 government primary and middle schools. Our computer teachers visit these schools and teach the children Computer Science for 50% of the time and Maths, English, Science etc. using innovative contents on their computer for the remaining 50% of the time. All our computer teachers (and also regular teachers) have a laptop with internet connection (4G through the phone hotspot). Our projects have been running for a few years and many of our computers have started developing problems. We have had to pull back some of the computers we had donated to schools and even some of the computers given to the regular teachers in order to ensure that the computer teachers get a laptop. Giving new laptops to the computer teachers will free up our resources and it will also enable the computer teachers to effectively do their work. The children going to government schools are among the poorer sections of the population in these rural areas and the better off families try to send their children to private schools.

In 7 of the villages, Asha is also running libraries. Four of these are in Thoothukudi dist, two in Villupuram and one in Thiruvallur dist. These are libraries which are used by children and a couple of the libraries are also used by adults. While we have books for the children to use, we do not have any computers or tablets in these libraries. As Asha already has access to a lot of educational contents (games, videos etc.), we can put these to good use by making it available for the children to use in the library as well. We hope to provide laptops and tablets to these libraries. We are

also planning to open 4 more libraries. These resources will be shared with the new libraries as well when we open them.
