

Site visit Report to Besant Theosophical Higher Secondary School

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BTHS school provides the option of English medium from 6th std onwards till 10th std. The school does not have computers for teaching students from 6th std to 10th std at present.

Jaya, Vijaya and Kasturi visited Olcott Memorial School on March 9, 2015 to see and understand the feasibility of setting up a Computer Centre at the Besant Theosophical Higher Secondary School.

Jaya and Vijaya did a site visit on March 9, 2015 to the school and met the Headmistress of the school who evinced keen interest in making the children computer literate. The teachers in the school are also interested in learning and imparting computer knowledge to the middle and high school children. The correspondent of the school Mr Ponnusamy gave his verbal consent as he could not meet us due to exams. We have agreed to pass on the proposal once it gets approved at the meeting so he can get acceptance from his management.

Need computer infrastructure to be installed in a hall that was used thus far as audio visual room no longer used but is well ventilated and situated isolated from the main building and is about 750sq ft. (30 ft by 25 ft).





The objective is to set up a lab and hire teacher, lab assistant and run the centre as Asha Chennai project. The Audiovisual room that has been identified for this project has proper ventilation, lighting that is needed. Our goal is to set up and run the lab for two - three years after which the teachers and BTHSS would be fully trained to run the centre.
