(2022 to 2023)

Period - April (2022) to March (2023) :

We are able to successfully completed another one year in reaching remote tribal area Adivasi kids to provide basic learning skills. With support of Asha 5 learning centers with 88 children, 51 boys and 37 girls completed one year learning program.

District bifurcation- new Districts:

Since 2022, May, Andhra Pradesh Government formulated new districts dividing old ones. Before May, all the learning centers part of Vishakhapatnam district but after May these villages / habitation know party of Alluri Seetharamaraju district. We request downers to understand the changing the name of District.

Major common programs:

January 26th and 15th August 2023:

All the schools celebrated Republic day and Independence Day this is January 26th and 15th August, involving village community.

Eye Camp on 13-02-2023 :

Three NGO organizations, Aloka, ZEISS,ASDS want to conducted eye camp in the remote tribal area habitations. Our teachers shown great enthusiasm to involve in this eye camp p. Many tribal people, particularly old persons suffering with eye problems. Hence we readily accepted their idea to conducted eye camp in the villages where the learning centers working. On 13-02-2023 at Udapalem Village of G.Madugula mandal eye camp was conducted. Before that day, the teacher volunteers vent to the villages and informed the local people about the eye camp. They also visited nearby tradition weakly markets (Santhalu) and distributed pamphlets. Teacher volunteers also mobilized the local youth to help for volunteer work in eye camp. On 13th, more than 300 tribal people from 42 villages, 4 mandals attended the camp.



In this camp, 187 glass distributed and 70 tribal people identified to need eye operations. Along with teacher volunteers, 20 volunteers including two German eye specialist take part on the camp.

Kid's excursion tour to Visakhapatnam :

A Childers excursion tour program was organized in the month of March 2023 from 14th to 16th. 41 children (selected from 12 learning centers) and 13 teachers, 7 support staff participated in this event. The Children visited Railway Station,

Zoo park, Kailasa Giri, beach at Vishakhapatnam. on 15th they traveled from Ankapalli to Vishakhapatnam by train and most of them first time traveled in the train and also saw the first time sea.



The concept of ABC Grouping of children:

Our play schools was a single teacher and single room (hall) schools. But the children was made groups (informally) as for their learning stages. The children were divided in three groups, this is A.B.C

Generally “A” group means, elder kids who was learning fast their other kids and these kids will be going to Tribal welfare schools. The “B” group was below the A group and ‘c’ group are small / little kids.

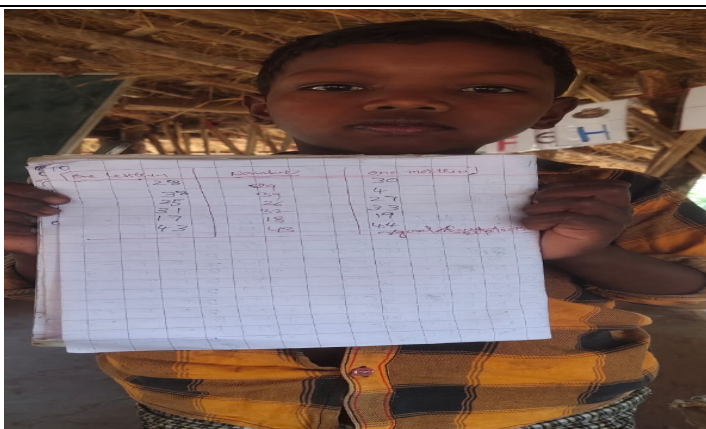
