### **Period - April (2024) to March (2025) :**

We are able to successfully complete another one year in reaching remote tribal area Adivasi kids to provide basic learning skills. With support of Asha 6 learning centers with 125 children, 64 boys and 61 girls completed one year learning program.

## **Children's day Celebration:**



On November 12th, a flash mob was held with the children of Sankaran's Tata Atala Badi (School) in G Madugula. 39 children from 13 School, each school 3), 13 teachers, coordinator, Facilitator, village supporters and founder P.S Ajaykumar garu attended this flash mob. Children from each school performed song with dance.

In G.Madugula mandal headquarter every Tuesday is the traditional market day, locally called “Santha” and people from different villages will visit the market place. On 12 of November 2024 the Children flash mob conducted in the Market place. Many tribal people observed the program and appreciated the kids.



First time, the children came on stage without any fear and performed what they had learned in their schools. It increased the confidence level of the children and made them very happy.

## **Kid's excursion tour to Visakhapatnam:**

A Childers excursion tour program was organized in the month of February 2025 from 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>. 29 Children (selected from 6 learning centers) and 6 teachers, 1 facilitator, 5 support staff total 41 members participated in this event. The Children visited Zoo Park, Kailasa Giri, R.K



Beach and Submarine at Vishakhapatnam. They kids are very enjoying the trip. School bags were given as gifts all the children who participating in this tour



### **Health camp on 23-02-2025:**

We observed in the school visits, many kinds suffering with scabies. We conducted a preliminary survey in the schools and find more than 125 kids suffering with this skin problem. This problem expending to other family members too. Some of the children not coming to school due to in health. To address this medical problem we conducted a one day awareness program on 23-2-2025 at Madugula mandal headquarter. We invited village people, men and women to this program. Dr. Divy Teja from Anakapalli gave basic tips to address the problem.



On the same day, Dr. Divya Teja Garu visited Addathigala and Mullumetta villages and he examined the children and their parents distributed medicine to them.

### **The concept of ABC Grouping of children:**

1. Our play schools was a single teacher and single room (hall) schools. But the children was made groups (informally) as for their learning stages. The children were divided in three groups, this is A.B.C
2. Generally "A" group means, elder kids who was learning fast then other kids and these kids will be going to Tribal welfare schools in future. The "B" group was below the A group and 'c' group are small / little kids.



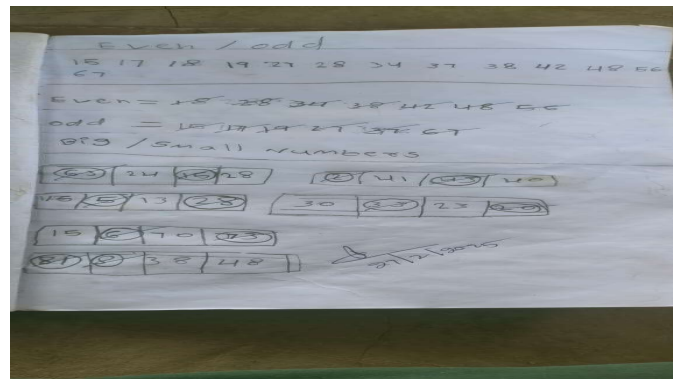


