Under the project Vidya, Ms Vidya and her team periodically visiting to review meeting and conducting training to teachers to help increase their capacity. The introduced three important elements to schools , they are 1. English rayims with action, 2. simple concepts of Maths with games, using teaching material and third is 3. English word formation with the help of teaching material and simple games. Ms Vidya team painstakingly prepared a manual (100 pages) for the schools and also prepared a teaching kit (photos – given below). These aliments greatly improved our teachers teaching skills and it gives a self confidence to over teachers.

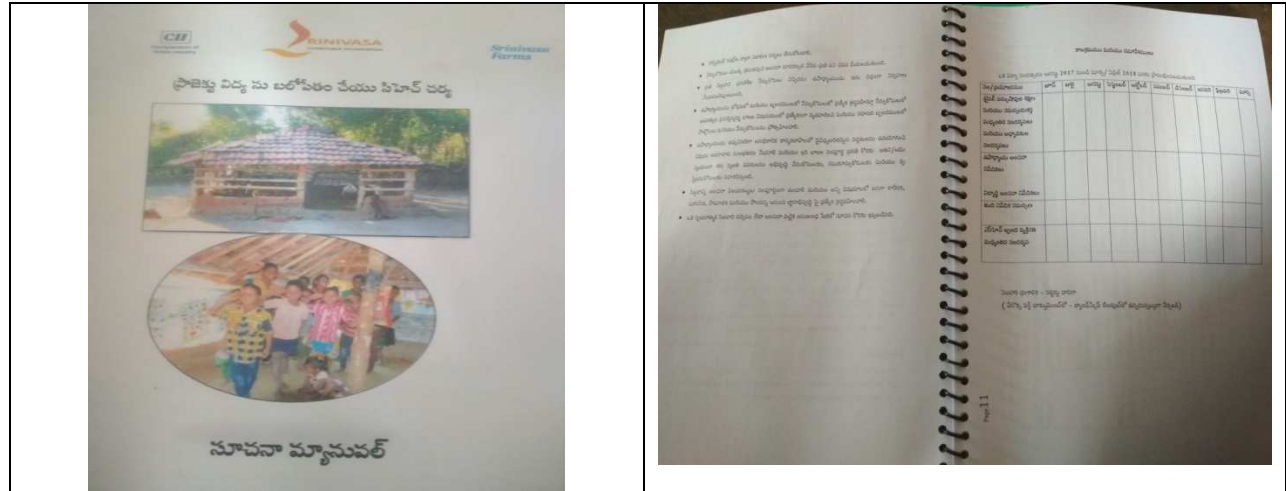

This three schools teacher volunteers went to the training in September and out of three, the started in the October. Out of three, two school started with good beginning (one cane see their progress in above video clips). When we made filed visit we observed in Rochupanuku the children are less than 10. And Rayipalem also facing the same problem. Losing there is more than 20 kids and this village is on the top of hill, but the teachers volunteer stopped the school in January , 2018 without informing. We are in searching for an alternative volunteer in the village. since January the school is not opened. From January 2018 we stopped the two schools this is Rochupanuku and Rayipalem. And started our search for two villages .

Mr. Ajay Kumar visited a Kondh village called 'Ambalamamidi' of Solabam Panchayiti of G.Madugula Mandal on 13th December 2017. He find, there is government school building but the school was closed long back. In March 2018, we started play school in this village .

సమస్యలు :-

1. స్కూల్ ఎంపిక చేసిన తరువాత టీచర్ సొంత సమస్యలు వలన స్కూల్ మానేయడం జరుగుతుంది. ఒక వాలంటీర్లు ఎంపిక చేసిన శిక్షణ ఇవ్వడానికి 5,000 ఖర్చు వస్తున్నది. తీరా అలా శిక్షణ పొందిన వారు మానేస్తే మరొకరిని ఎంపిక చేసి మళ్ళీ శిక్షణకు పంపడానికి సమయం పడుతున్నది. అది పాటశాల నిర్వహణ పై ప్రభావం చూపుతున్నది.
2. తల్లిదండ్రులు పిల్లలను స్కూల్ కి పంపించకుండా వారితో పాటు పనికి తీసుకుపోవడం. ముఖ్యంగా డిసెంబరు నుండి ఫిబ్రవరి మధ్య ఈ సమస్య ఎక్కువగా వుంటుంది. అందుకు కారణం, అది ఆ నెలలో పంట కోతల సమయంలో ఆదివాసీలు ఉదయాన్ని పొలాలకు వెళ్ళి పోతూ పిల్లలను తీసుకు వెళ్తున్నారు.
3. టీచర్ కి ఇచ్చే జీతం చాలకపోవడం వలన స్కూల్ మానేయడం జరుగుతుంది. ప్రస్తుతం అందరికీ మేము 4000 ఇస్తున్నాం.
4. స్కూల్ ఎంపిక చేసిన కొన్ని నెలలు గడిచిన తరువాత టీచర్ కి గ్రామస్తులు సహకరించక పోవడం జరుగుతున్నది. ఇందులో స్త్రీకి వెభేదాలు కూడా ప్రభావం చూపుతున్నాయి
5. టీచర్ కి వేరే opportunity వస్తే స్కూల్ మానేస్తున్నారు.
