### Introduction

Asha Rajatlab (NJSS) was started in 1994 which works on education in various 70 village of Aaraji line block at district Vanarasi (Uttar Pradesh). Through the Asha Rajatlab (NJSS), villagers registered their active participation not only in the field of education but also in other vital areas like building a discrimination-free society, women leadership, women empowerment, teenage girls education.

The organization provides primary education in a center and non-formal education (Vocational training program) in about 10 kishori kendras and more than 80 self help groups in Eastern Uttar Pradesh.

#### **Mission**

To catalyze socio-economic change in our society through the education of underprivileged children.

#### **Objectives**

- 1- To provide primary education and non-formal education to under privileged children.
- 2- Pay special attention to the education of girls, develop awareness about their rights through education. by providing non formal education and vocational training to the young and married women.
- 3- Developing self help groups of women for economic independency, leadership and empowerment.



## **Asha Gyan Library**

Asha Gyan Library, run by Asha Trust and Lok Samiti. the purpose of opening the library is that no child can stop studies due to lack of books, can choose his future ahead. From the library till now. 836 students, girl students are involved, following the COVID rules, distribution of books was issued to all the children along with sanitizers and masks, so that the education of the children is not wasted due to the closure of the school during the lockdown period, which was quite successful. Career workshops are also organized from time to time for the children of the library so that the children can make their career.

Objectives achieved: During the surge in second wave, the distribution of books to the children of rural continued. labors and the needy children Furthermore, since the schools were closed children were completing their studies through the library through which books were issued in the library at free of cost. With the help of students, nutrition kit, sanitary pad and mask were distributed to the girls. Students who have passed class 10 and 12 were also welcomed to contribute to the distribution kits and providing their own textbooks to the current students. **Those** who cleared government examinations also volunteered to provide books to the current government job seeking aspirants.

**Project Area:** In continuity of the work that is going on now, we wish to concentrate our work in the same area of operation as the area of the previous project. Seventy village panchayats spread out in Two Blocks, namely Araji line and Sewapuri in the District of Varanasi form our area of operation

#### Women Self-help Group

There are 260 women self help groups are organized in different villages and more than 5200 women are the member of this group.

## Campaign for Women's Leadership & SHG Groupe:

Asha and Lok Samiti works through the self-help female groups against sexual child violence, violence, liquor marriage, dowry, murder, saleacross 70 villages of Araji Line and Sevapuri block. SHGs help the women become self-reliantand also helps to get rid of money lenders in the village. A total of 260 groups are currently being run across these villages

## Right to Livelihood Campaign:

- Awareness campaign: street plays and pamphlet distribution regarding Panchayat elections
- Across different areas of the villages of Araji lines and Sevapuri block, the antiwomen molestation protests were held, starting from November 25<sup>th</sup> till 15<sup>th</sup> December
- On Dec16th on Nirbhaya Diwas and at the conclusion of the Anti-women violence protests, women participated in large numbers in a walking rally and submitted a list of demands to the SDM of Rajatalab
- Street plays were conducted to raise awareness on various issues
- Economic independency.
- Strengthening women leadership.
- Action against social evil (alcoholism, child marriage, domestic violence and women issue.
- Providing training and workshop on the issue of gender, women rights, sexuality and sustainable menstruation.

## **Migrant labourers and day Labor Union:**

- Youth and Daily Labourer Group
- 450 daily laborers were registered for the work programs
- 325 daily laboreres received their labor cards
- To help save the environment, campaign was conducted in 25 villages through street plays, informational rallies and handing out plants for people to plant in their houses
- To help fight against the pandemic, 4 COVID help desks were established and medicines were also distributed through them
- 2500 masks were distributed to the daily laborers
- 400 daily laborers received nutrition kits and daily rations
- To prevent the spread of COVID, sanitization treatments were done in 10 villages and 10 market places
- Vaccine awareness was created through informational posters and pamphlet distribution
- Health camps helped in conducting 1250 RT-PCR tests, 475 people in the 45+ age group and 1120 people in the 18+ age group were vaccinated
- Independence Day and Holi was celebrated by the Youth and Daily Laborer Groups
- A workers union was created at the Block level and the leadership positions were appointed. Dilip Kumar was chosen to be the leader of the union
- Organized program among the laborers to encourage them to participate in elections
- Under the women marriage program, the daughters of 5 of the registered laborers received aid to take care of marriage expenses

## **Teen Girl's Vocational and Sewing Centers:**

- 9 new sewing centers were opened. Around 200 girls is learning.
- Online training was also done to the girls educating them about their health, menstruation and gender issues.
- The occasion of 'Balika Diwas' was organized.girls demanded for their rights to education and lead a working life rather than living under social turmoil of restrictions.
- Pamphlets were distributed to all the women and girls associated with the sewing centers talking about health and menstruation. Sanitary pads were distributed to about 500 people.
- Adolescent girls were taken to the police station for administrative information, and the girls inquired about their safety from the police station staff and learned about the toll-free number
- Blankets, boxes and tables were distributed at all sewing centers.
- On the occasion 16<sup>th</sup> December, the day of honoring Nirbhaya, girls protested against molestation, sexual harassment, female infanticide/foeticide, child marriage, dowry, etc, and participated in a cycle rally and handed over their demands to SDM of Rajatalab
- The girls were taken for an educational tour to Sitamadi, Vindhyachal, Sarved Mandir, Sarnath, Lalpur Museum, etc

#### **COVID Relief Program**

- •Under the COVID Relief Program, the 25000 masks made by the sewing centers were ditributed amongst the children of the Asha Samajik Vidyalaya, daily laborers union, kishori kendra girls, and women of the SHGs
- •To prevent the spread of COVID, sanitization treatments were done in 10 villages and 10 market places











Covid Relief Program: In the Arajiline and Sevapuri blocks, about 1500 bags of rations were distributed amongst the disabled, sick, needy and unsupported people. Ration kit included rice, dal, wheat flour, soya-beans, salt, turmeric, coriander, sugar, oil, biscuits, etc















In addition 700 ration kits were distributed to people who affected by floods













4500 nutrition kits and santization kits were distributed amonst the union workds and daily laborers. Nutrition kit contained – dal, oil, sugar, almonds, jaggery, soyabeans, salt, etc and Sanitization kit contains –mask, sanitizer, sanitary pads, soaps, shampoo, washing powder



















350 children of Asha Samajik Vidyalaya received nutrition kits – chavanprash, garbanzo beans, allmonds and sugar, and sanitization kits. In addition 50 adolescent girls received undergarments and sanitary pads



400 girls of the Kishori Kendras received nutrition kits (chavanprash, garbanzo beas, almonds, jaggery, soyabeans, tea, biscuits, etc) and sanitzation kits (mask, panties, sanitary pads, shampoo, soap, washing powder)











### Health: From the Primary Health Center in Nagepur, more then 15000 people have been seen and treated since the start of COVID











Health: With the help of the Mobile Van Ambulance, health camps were organized in 40 Vallage and 4800 people were examined and received medicines







Health: In 20 villages, primary health clinics were established, where 80 youth were given training regarding primary health and given health kits, so that they could help those in need





















### Health: Health camps were organized vaccination awerness camp in 50 Village, and 6000 people were vaccinated and tested for COVID
