

Minutes of talk by Sandhya and Sarit in July 2017

Sandhya and Sarit from Aavishkaar visited Purdue in the first week of July 2017. Approximately 20 attendees including Asha Purdue volunteers, donors and students from Purdue University attended the talk titled "Asha Ed-Talks". She also shared her plans of starting a fellowship program to train youth in the education sector who can then become change-makers in their respective communities.
