General News:

Hariksha People's Welfare Trust General Board Meeting took place on 5th June, in Rainbow Life Children Home campus. In this meeting the Board of Trustees are partcipated and discussion made about the organization, projects, financial and other information.

The Managing Director participated the quarterly review conducted by the District Child Protection Office in Tiruvannamalai Collector Office, headed by the District Magistrate (Collector) and various department heads. In this meeting discussion were made about various children related issues (Child Marriage, Children Homes and Guidance, etc.,) in Tiruvannamalai District.

The Managing Trustee participated the meeting of Pudhu Vazhvu Project, in Ganesh Hotel, Villupuram. We made presentation about our organization, the vocational training materials are displayed and small training made to the all CDF of Pudhu Vazhvu Project.





Mr. Baskaran(Q-Brik) - Chennai, extended his valuable, generous, timely support to Hariksha Learning Centre to manage the financial crisis situation. The contribution of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh Rupees) helped us to handle the all over aspect of Hariksha Learning Centre.

The Learning Centre is re-opened after the summer vacation on 6th June, before the re-open the staff team members are cleaned the complete building and the campus from 1st June, the staff team members are prepared the Pre-primary, Primary and Vocational class children's goals for the coming academic year 2016-2017.

New Admission

For the last two months newly identified children are got admitted in our Learning Centre. Our early intervention will develop the children and having good possibilities to restore with the society with equal rights and opportunities.

On 1st June 2016, (Wednesday) the boy Sasikumar, 14 years, from Naranamangalam god admitted in our Learning Centre.

The boy Kumaravel, 13 years, father name Govindharaj, mother name Janaki from Vettaikaran patti got admitted in our Learning Centre on 17th June

The child M. Kannan, 7 years, got admitted in our learning centre on 24th June, he is from Melmalayanur Village, his father is Manigandan, his mother name is Kannammal.

Vishali, 4 ¹/₂ years (DOB 22.08.2011) child got admitted in our Learning Centre on 1st July, her father is Madhavan & mother is Valarmathi, she is from the village Muruganthangal.

On 31st July the child Kandhan, 4 years (DOB 31.08.2012) got admitted in our Learning Centre. He is from Muruganthangal village. The parents are Ramachandiran & Indumathy.

Iyyappan, 4 years child admitted in our Learning Centre on 1st July in Hariksha Learning Centre, he belongs to Muruganthangal Village, his parents are Elumalai & Poongavanam.

M. Kannan is 7 years boy child, his father is Manigandan and mother is Kannammal. He is from Melmalayanoor Village, the contact mobile number is 8680887374. He is born with 1st degree consanguineous marriage.

The mother underwent the regular medical check up from the third month of the pregnancy. During the 8th month check up the doctors shared the information that the fetus is seems to be defective. During the delivery the doctors said that the circumference is big, so the chance of the normal delivery is very less. Then the child is delivered in the Caesarian method, during the delivery the child weighed about 3.30 kg., After the birth the child is cried after two hours only, due to the lack of mother's milk the child is fed with cow's milk.

During the developmental stage the mother and the family members noticed that the child's growth is lesser than normal child, the child seems to be 4 years of age and the function of the body also reflect the same.

The toilet skill of the boy is that he can pass urine in his own effort, while he wants to use the toilet he shows the fingers that he want pass stool. He can able to use the toilet, but he is not able to clean independently, some one has to help him. Every day morning he can able to brush his teeth using tooth brush and paste.

He says his hunger by holding the stomach that he wants food, he can eat the food with a little assistance (split the food into portions)

He is dependent to wear his own dresses. He can identify his father, mother & family members. He can say "Amma & Appa". If we ask him who is Kannan, he can index himself. He is not able to use communication skill. He can able understand what we explained to him, but he is not able to do it back. His socialization with his elder sister and same age children is good, he can able to play with them. He use to watch television (comics channel).

His peculiar attitude is he uses to uphold his head and shook it continuously.

The child J. Perarasu is the 3 years boy, his date of birth is 22.07.2013, his native village is Thazhangunam, his father is Jayabal, mother is Bavani. His father works as a seasonable coolie earning around Rs. 4,000/- per month.

The prenatal information shows that the mother underwent the regular and routine medical checkup and underwent all the instruction of the physicians. The delivery is carried out in the Government Hospital, Avalurpet, he is born with full term delivery, during the delivery the child weighed 3.5 kg and the doctors said that the child's lower limbs are paralyzed. The parents provided the child all the immunizations.

The child achieved the milestone (head control, crawling, sitting, standing, walking) delayed. His visual and auditory abilities are good. The activities of daily living skill is need to be trained, he is not aware of passing urine & stool, but after passing it he inform by one word communication. He can say "Appa & Amma". His socialization is good, he mingles with every body.

As the doctor informed during delivery that his lower limbs are paralyzed, he can able to move from one place to other place by crawling.

He can able to repeat the words which the trainer said to him, he also tries to follow it. If we call him by his name he is responding to it.

Member Legislative Assembly visit

The area Member Legislative Assembly Mr. Masthan, visited our centre on 7th June. To share the joy of his victory the party members arranged the lunch in our Learning Centre and they invited the MLA to facilitate it. On 7th June the MLA came to our centre, the staff team members welcomed him by garlanding the shawl, the children welcomed him by clapping their hand. He felt very happy to be with the children, he served food to the children, he spent his time with our children and he shows much interest to know about the activities of our Learning Centre.

Special Visits

On 14th July 39 students & 2 staff of the 3rd year, B. Sc., Nursing Students of Al Ameen Nursing College visited our learning centre, the activities of the centre and infra structure, teaching methodology are explained to them

On 28th July our well wisher Mr. Rajaram, visited our learning centre. He met the children, went around the Hariksha Learning Centre, explained the recent development took place in the learning centre, children's development and many other things. The purpose of the visit to explore the possibilities to extend the support from Asha Foundation.

Field Visit

The staff members Muniammal, Kamatchi & Shanthi went to the villages – Mekalur, Kodukankuppam, Melvailamur, Melmalayanur, Thorapadi, Thayanur, from 1st to 3rd of this month to prepare the children for the Learning Centre Re-opening.

Apart from this during Saturdays the staff team members visited the children in their houses.

In Hariksha Learning Centre we introduced the new activities that the children are taken to the vegetable market while we purchased the vegetables for the children. The shop selling activities in the Learning Centre is progress every week.







For all the staff team members in Hariksha Learning Centre are provided with **Rs. 500**/- rupees salary increment. This will help them manage the price hike.

Vehicle Annual Maintenance and Fitness

The school van's annual maintenance works are carried out, the vehicle painting works, tinkering works, replacing the new seat cover and all other maintenance works are carried over. On 26th June 2016 the annual Fitness Certificate process is completed. After all the annual maintenance work the vehicle is shown to the Regional Transport Officer for the Fitness, after verification of all the facilities as par with Government norms the Annual Fitness Certificate is issued by the authorities.



Due to the Annual fitness work process the children are transported using the Auto Rickshaw from 6^{th} June to 26^{th} June.

Physiotherapy Session

The weekly physio therapy session is took place 2 days in every week, the cerebrally palsied children Shalini, Archana, Srimurugan, Gokul, Gokula Kannan, Sarathy, Manjula, Arjun, Logarasi, Parameswari, Shanthi, Deepak, Karthik, Vignesh & Tamil are underwent the physiotherapy session.

Staff Meeting

- The staff are instructed to be precise on the children's quarterly goal preparation
- The team member are instructed to arrange the general health check up medical camp for the children
- Informed to train the driver to maintain the vehicle account and the documents
- Informed to the team members to make all their effort to bring the attendance of the parents at least once a month
- The staff team members are instructed to monitor the daily attendance of the children, (will help to know about the health status of the child and other purposes)
- The physiotherapist is informed that apart from the therapy to the children, it has to be recorded and need to be updated
- The driver is instructed to ensure the safe driving in the same time on time pick up and drop the children

KDM Trained Parents Discussion

We had discussion with KDM Therapy completed parents. In this meeting we had discussion and informed that the parents can practice their therapy techniques to the children living in their villages. We are not compelled them for the private practice, but we asked them why should they waste their learning, it can be utilized and useful to the needy children in their villages. Motivated the trained parents to serve as a resource person in their village.



Parents Meeting

The parents & staff consultative meeting took place on 2^{nd} July, in this meeting 24 parents are taken part and various discussion were carried out

- All parents relatives are requested to attend the meeting on time
- The discussion will allow and share the information about the Government Schemes, Child's improvement, issues from both side
- Informed the parents to share the discussion information to the absentees and insist them to attend the ahead meetings
- We explained the parents that the children are not coming here for only feeding and to spend the time, each and every activities is helping the development of the children
- It is explained to the parents, that to bring the professional trainer to the rural area is costing us lots of money, for eg: Physiotherapist costs Rs. 1,000/- per day

- The school van maintenance and running expenses costing higher, the current year annual maintenance costs around Rs. 80,000/-
- We explained to the parents that in the normal conventional school aims only the academic skills, but we are concentrating here the complete skill development of their children
- Again the refreshment information shared to the parents, the 3 months pre planned goals are explained to the parents and also the assessment details explained to them
- We explained to them that maximum all the basic needs and the facilities are provided to the children in free of cost
- The additional features washing machine to wash the children dresses, purified drinking water and many other facilities are providing to the children
- The adult girls are providing with sanitary napkin as per the need
- Each child is considered as an individual and individual treatment is providing to the children, we are designing the mobility equipments, children friendly equipments such us corner chair, CP Chairs. For a single child use sitting chair we spend around 35,000/- to make it, so we are concentrating the individual child development
- We also informed to the parents that all the information and activities and the monthly report is published in the website for the public viewing
- Also shared that the expenses details are also publishing in the website
- The parents again and again instructed to avail the Government maintenance Grant for their children
- Information shared that in Arjun's house the parents attention and care need to improve

General Medical Health Check up camp

On 15th of July the half yearly general medical health check up camp took place in the Government Hospital.

All the children are underwent complete health check up, the height and weight is measured. The opportunity sickness are treated immediately providing injection, medicines, nebulizer.





All the children are provided with the de warming tablet, and the doctor also provided the herbal powder which can be used to develop the immune power of the children and the children are provided with multivitamin tablets.

For Gokul the doctors provided with ointment towards his skin problem, Elumalai has tongue tie problem for which the doctor referred him to the Head Quarters Hospital for further treatment.

Towards the action of this circular from the Government we initiated the bank account for 19 children in our home, some of the children have already bank account. Altogether we have submitted all the children's bank account and required details to the District Child Protection Office on 18th July.

Girls bathroom and toilet become block the repairer work as done ready to use now.


Birthday
