## **Introduction**

Over the past decade, PARMARTH has been working towards strengthening of a community-based monitoring mechanism for schools, improving the processes determining quality of education, influencing the functioning of government schools, and advocating through campaigns to ensure effective implementation of the RTE Act with special focus on conditions of learning and child friendly elements of schools.

The goal of this ongoing project is to continue the operation of the After-School Learning Center (Kishor Kaushal Vikas Kendra) set up in Madhogarh in early 2018 with assistance from Asha for Education, Princeton Chapter. The tutoring at this Block Level Learning Centre contributes to addressing the critical gaps of the poor & marginalized children. Through this Learning Center, gaps in learning are addressed and special attention given to struggling students to bring them to mainstream. In this Learning Center, daily tuition classes are conducted in the subjects of Mathematics, Science and English. Additionally, special classes of music, life skills, motivation, digital education and home science are also conducted. External subject experts are invited /called to this Learning Center from time to time. This Learning Center is running in Madhogarh Block and ensures additional support to children who do not have enough resources to pay for private coaching.

## **Parmarth Kaushal Vikas Kendra**

Parmarth Kaushal Vikas Kendra has been developed as a unique resource for providing both education as per curriculum and education/information useful for life of the children using innovative and interesting teaching / learning methodologies.

## **Critical support**

The project continues to provide personalized support as per requests by the school administration. Critical support is also provided as per the needs and vulnerabilities of particular children.

## **Expected outcomes**

- Learning gaps of the student will be addressed.
- Quality education will be ensured among student in the project areas.
- Increase in attendance and performance of the student.
- Dropped out student especially girls & marginalized student will be mainstreamed.
- Continuity in education will be ensured in the project operational areas.
