About the School

- Established in 2001 for visually impaired and blind kids
- Initial enrollment was 18 students in Vizianagaram
- Moved to Visakhapatnam in 2013
- Today there are 115 kids (boys + girls) in the dorms
- 10 classrooms
- 14 teachers
- Owns the school building in Visakhapatnam
- Supported for most part by the Jeeyar Educational trust funds

Objectives of the school

- Provide education to the visually impaired children from the tribal areas in and around Visakhapatnam
- Most of the children are from the families of fisherman, daily laborers where the literacy rate in these areas is below 30%
- All the children live on the school premises
- The focus of the school is to make these children capable of living independently

Current Funding

- Corpus funds
- Donations and contribution from individuals

Services provided

- Students are trained in vocational courses like candle making, paper bags, wire bags, greeting cards, friendship bands, glass painting,
- Excellent in singing, drama and dance,
- Teachers follow the state board syllabus and students write exams with the help of scribes

Current needs

- Need funds to pay for teacher salaries:
 - Permanent teachers INR 1,85,000
 - Non-teaching staff INR 35,000
- Food expenses INR 1,50,000
- Miscellaneous INR 1,00,000
