Note - INR 388,000 (377,025+11175) was sent for the teachers' salaries based on 10% hike in July 2018 which is usually paid from August. The funds sent in September (first disbursement) did not account for the hike in Aug/Sept and hence additional 11,175 was sent. Some of the teachers - Social, Computer Science, English and Braille got more than 10% hike because they were being paid less for the work they were doing and also they were doing an excellent jobs with the kids which was not mentioned to us. Hence the deficit of 4,308.
