- English Medium School was set up in 2010, primarily to provide education to our Rehab Center children who were struggling in mainstream school as their HIV medication and restricted health affected their concentration and attendance. As our school has expanded, we have opened our doors to children from our neighbouring communities, providing subsidised fees and materials to those from poorer incomes.

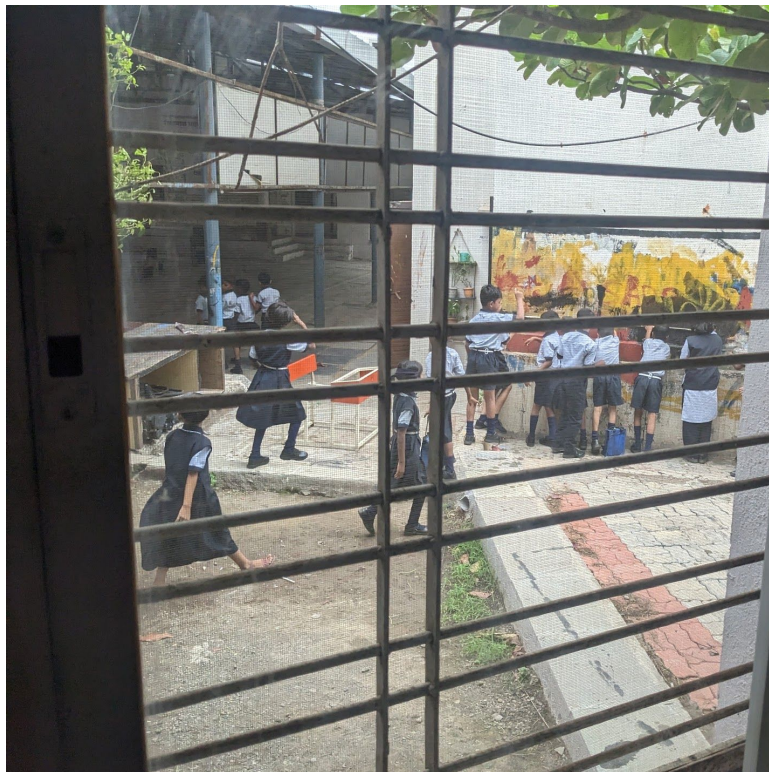

SNEH DNYANDEEP PROJECT

“Empowering marginalized children through Education”

Background

With the strong belief that “Education is the true foundation of development,” we aim to address the challenge of irregular school attendance, declining interest in learning, and high dropout rates among municipal school children.

The Sneh Dnyandeep Program has been implemented in two selected municipal schools for a period of 12 months as a pilot. Drawing on Snehalaya’s successful two-decade experience with the Balbhavan Project (an afterschool project to ensure that all slum children are brought in the mainstream of education) the initiative seeks to enhance attendance, improve education quality, reintegrate out-of-school children, and foster holistic personality development through joyful, innovative, and inclusive methods.

This is being extended to 4 additional schools.

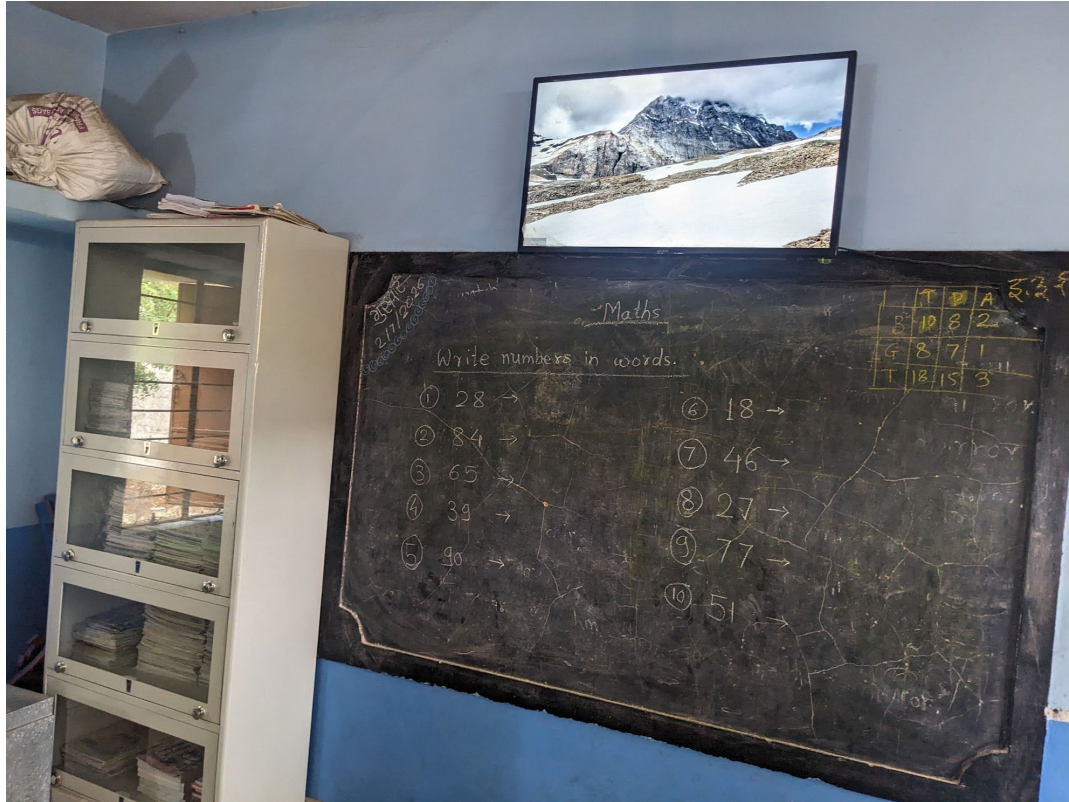
