Madhya pradesh

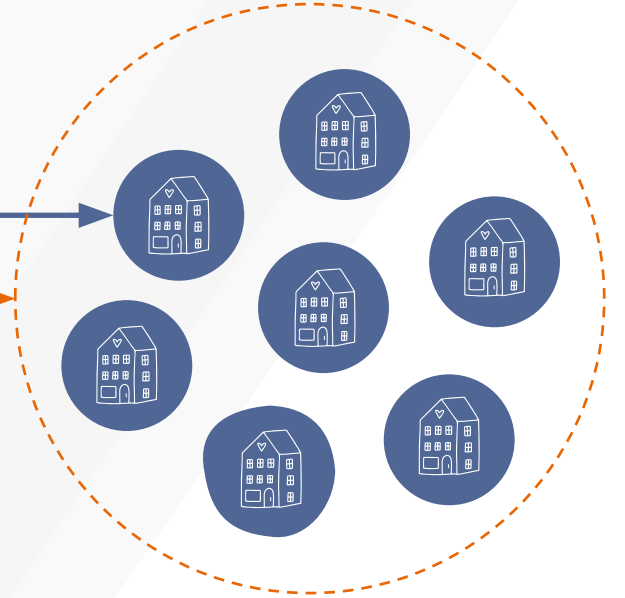


Personnel at a Seva Kutir

- 3-4 Teachers
- 2-3 Cooks

Seva Kutir are organized in clusters

- Each cluster is composed of 5-7 Kutirs in a 10-15 KMs radius
- Each cluster is supervised by 2 coordinators

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Parivaar Seva Kutirs in Madhya Pradesh



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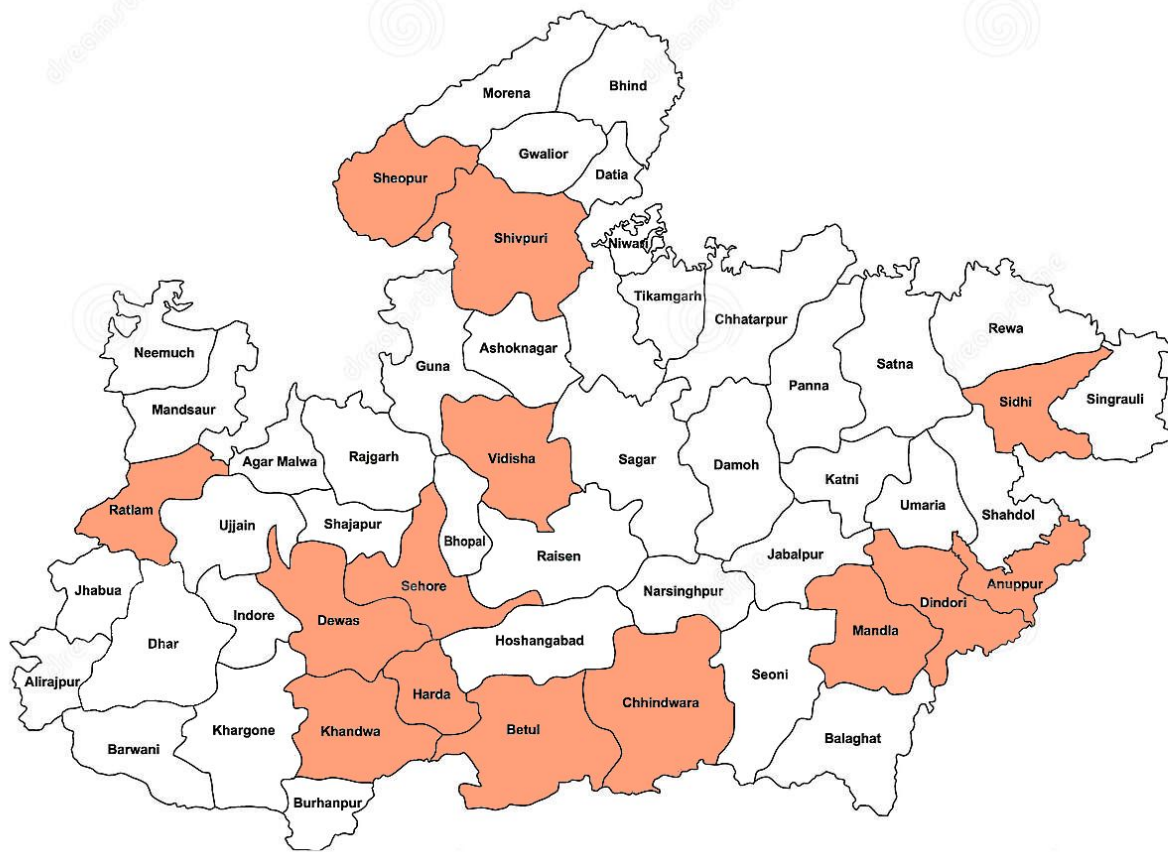
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681 Seva Kutirs are currently operational **in over 15 districts** with **more than 50,000 children** getting nutritious meals (breakfast and dinner) along with Strong Supplementary education and life-skills over morning and evening shifts ~around 6 hours of engagement daily (except Sundays), all round the year.

Complementing and Partnering with Government Systems

The whole concept of Seva Kutir was built on the **premise of complementing the existing government systems and schemes.** The nutrition aspect that the Seva Kutirs have undertaken is to **complement the mid day meal scheme** by providing nutritious food for the remaining two meals, i.e. breakfast and dinner. Educationally the Kutirs by holding sessions with government school children in the morning and evening slots (after and before school) aim to assist the children in their school curriculum by making children over 7 years grade ready and under 7 years school ready.

- **Mutually designed curriculum:** We are already working with district school authorities regarding our work in Kutirs we **have shared our curriculum with them each month.** We will be doing so with the teachers in the schools that the Kutir children attend and also ask them feedback and where they require help from us specific to some subjects. In informal discussions with some such teachers they have asked us to **particularly focus on Maths and Science** since many drop outs in the region are because of inability to understand these two subjects.
- Upgrading teaching methodologies: We **hold trainings for our Kutir teachers every month;** District education authorities are encouraging their teachers from the villages (where Kutirs are) to participate as well.

Residential Campus for Tribal Children at Village Sandalpur, District Dewas



This campus is spread in around 17 acres. There is a school building and 4 residential buildings, three of which are hostels for boys and one for volunteers and guests. The school is affiliated to the MP Education Board and has started from the Academic Session 2021-22. There are around 590 resident children at present. They study in Grades VI to VIII. These children are from poor tribal families from 8 districts of MP - Dewas, Sehore, Khandwa, Harda, Betul, Vidisha, Alirajpur and Barwani. This will be scaled to more than 2000 children in the next 3 years.



Residential Campus for Girls at Village - Amla Noabad, District Sehore

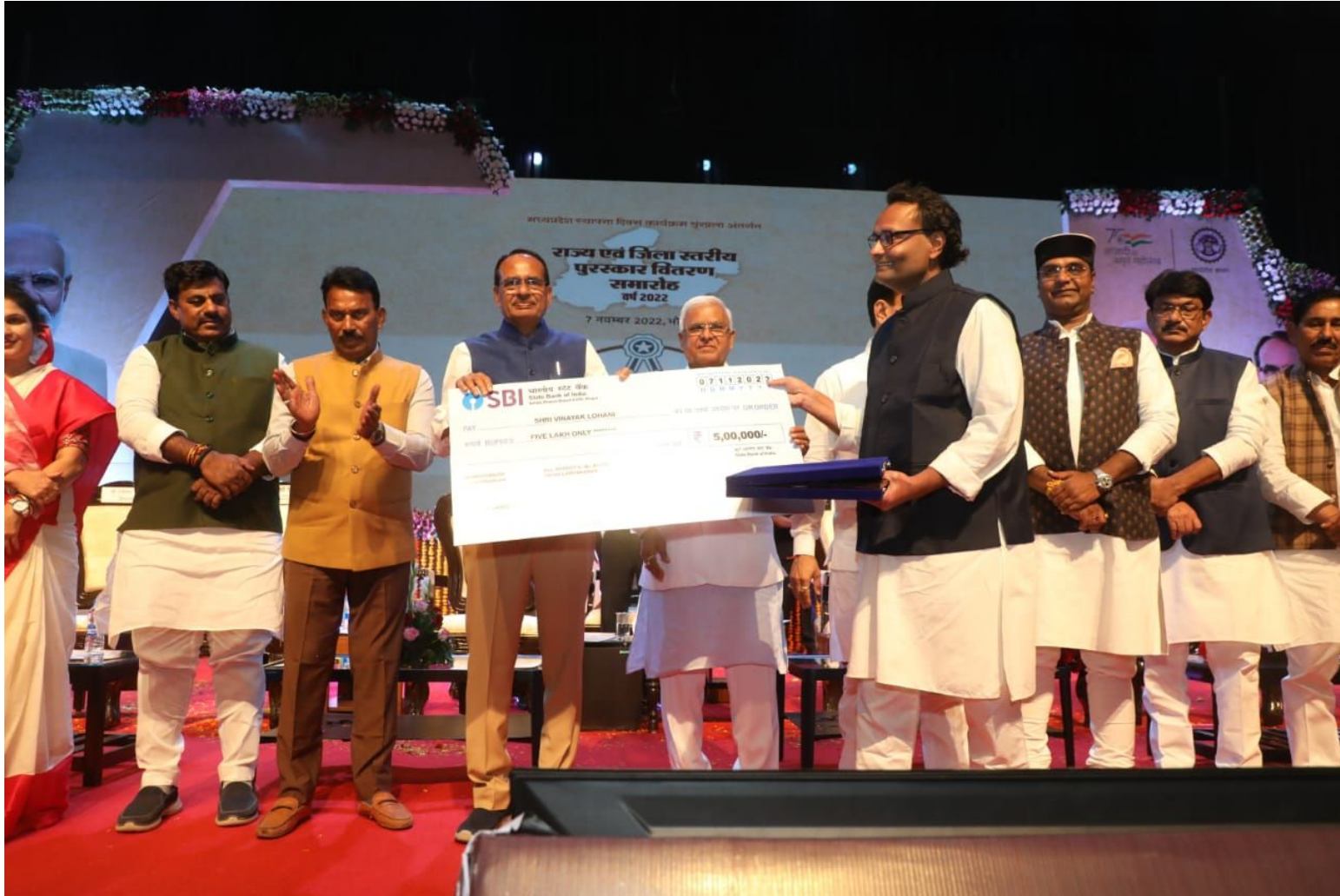
A smaller school and residential block in Village Amla Novabad in Ichhwar Tehsil of Sehore District has started functioning from July 2022. There are around 140 girls from poor tribal families of 7 districts - Dewas, Sehore, Khandwa, Betul, Harda, Vidisha, and Barwani.



Hostel in Mandla Town for Girls and Boys

We are running hostels for girls and boys from poor tribal families of various villages of Mandla district. The hostel is in Mandla town, and the children are enrolled in the Government Schools nearby. There are around 200 boys and girls, studying in Grades IX to XII.

Madhya Pradesh Gaurav Samman Conferred On Parivaar



MP state government has conferred “Madhya Pradesh Gaurav Samman” on Parivaar and the award was given by Hon. Governor and the Chief Minister on 7th November, 2022 for exceptional work in the field of health and nutrition.

Integration with Government Schools

Parivaar has been continuously working on the vertical integration of its Seva Kutir Program. Apart from admitting Seva Kutir students to our own residential institutions, we also try to get Seva Kutir children admitted to govt. residential Institutions and other schools set up by the government. Awareness and special attention in the form of extra classes or additional syllabus is paid to the students who are eligible to get admitted to these schools.

Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS)

Eklavyas are the residential schools set up by Govt of India to impart quality education to ST children in remote areas. The schools are set up at block levels and cater to students from class VI to XII. The admissions to these schools are made through an entrance test in class VI only. These schools follow syllabus either of CBSE or State Education Boards. There are 63 functional Eklavya Schools in Madhya Pradesh. 121 children, including 52 girls from Parivaar Seva Kutirs have been enrolled in these EMRS for the session 2022-23.

Kanya Shiksha Parisar (KSP)

Kanya Shiksha Parisars are the residential schools set up by Govt of India for Girls from Scheduled Tribes. The schools are set up at block levels and cater to students from class VI to XII. The admissions to these schools are made through an entrance test in class VI and in class IX for vacant seats. These schools follow syllabus either of CBSE or State Education Boards. There are 82 KSPs in Madhya Pradesh. **128 girls from Parivaar Seva Kutirs** have been enrolled in these KSPs for the session 2022-23.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNV)

Navodaya Vidyalayas are residential and Co-Ed schools run by Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, an autonomous organization under MoE, India. These schools provide education to the children of rural areas regardless of their social status. The schools are set up at district levels and cater to students from class VI to XII. The admissions to these schools are made through an entrance test in class VI, entrance test in class IX for vacant seats and based on merit in class X for class XI. These schools are affiliated to CBSE. There are 54 JNVs in Madhya Pradesh. **13 students, including 5 girls from Parivaar** Seva Kutirs have been enrolled in these JNVs for the session 2022-23.

School of Model (SOM)/ Model School

Model Schools are day-boarding and Co-Ed schools set up by Govt of Madhya Pradesh. These schools provide quality education to the children regardless of their social status. The schools are set up at block levels and cater to students from class VI to XII. The admissions to these schools are made through an entrance test in class VI, entrance test in class IX for vacant seats and based on merit in class X for class XI. These schools follow the syllabus of either CBSE or MP Board. There are 201 functional Model Schools in Madhya Pradesh. **29 children, including 18 girls from Parivaar Seva Kutirs** have been enrolled in these Model Schools for the session 2022-23.
