




3 Education Support







Snehachhaya a unique Child Care Institute under the framework of the Juvenile Justice Act. Approved by The Women and Child Development and Social Welfare Department, this was set up in 2017 for accommodating girls, rescued by the Police. Since inauguration, over 1000 girls have been taken care of by the institute. 375 girls have been successfully rehabilitated at their respective places after necessary counselling & supportive measures. Snehachhaya has been awarded as the "Best Child Care Institution" run by NGO, 2023, by West Bengal Commission for Protection of Child Rights!













During the COVID-19 pandemic, a unique idea emerged – the creation of Antyodoy Anath Ashram's remarkable 'Organic Vegetable Garden on Water.' The concept aimed to address the challenge of providing sustenance in space-constrained areas. With a three-acre land that included ponds, the solution became clear – utilize the ponds for agricultural purposes.

While it's common for people to cultivate vegetables near ponds, an innovative twist was introduced here. Instead of traditional methods, the idea of creating a floating garden around the pond, like a protective hat,

was born. The goal was not only to boost vegetable production but also to safeguard the pond's fish

population.

Covering three acres, the garden floats gracefully over four ponds, home to various indigenous fish species such as Rohu, Carp (Katla), Striped Snakehead (Shoal), and Catfish (Magur), it's evident that their development exceeds ordinary expectations.

Balaram Karan, the visionary behind this ashram, proudly attests that all these vegetables are cultivated organically without the use of harmful chemicals. The bounty of these gardens plays a vital role in providing nutritious meals to the ashram's residents.

The process begins with creating nutrient-rich soil around the pond, blending components like using lime, cow dung, lime, and sand. Then, carefully selected seeds are planted, nurtured, and grown on bamboo platforms, creating a lush canopy over the pond. This not only provides shade for the fish but also acts as a protective barrier, preventing fish theft and maintaining their health.

The ashram has its unique approach to dealing with tree diseases. Sukumar Samanta and Ashwini Barikra take care of the plants. They mentioned that no pesticides are used. The sap from neem leaves is sprayed to combat tree diseases and pests. When it comes to seed selection, they produce their own seeds from large pumpkins. Similar methods are used for other vegetables as well. In many cases, seeds are sourced from the Block Agriculture Department.

Antyodoy Anath Ashram's Floating Organic Vegetable Garden serves as a guiding light of innovation and sustainability. This remarkable initiative not only addresses the constraints of limited space but also exemplifies responsible, pesticide-free organic farming practices, all the while ensuring the nourishment of the ashram's residents.

Antyodoy Anath Ashram exemplifies a commitment to sustainability through the integration of solar panels as a secondary renewable energy source. By harnessing the sun's power, the ashram not only reduces its dependence on conventional electricity but also significantly lowers its environmental impact. This forward-thinking approach aligns with a broader goal of fostering eco-friendly practices.


