Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs);

Samagra Seva is operating Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) to improve the educational level of children from the Mushar community. These Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) are running for 6 to 14 years aged children.



These Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) are being run especially for those children who are dropped out from school and are weak in studies. Such children are connected to Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) and are assisted in the process of re-enrollment in school. The Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) operates daily in the morning and evening in which children come to study

before going to school or after coming back from school. Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) are running in 55 villages of Jamui and Khaira block in which total 1655 children aged 6-14 years are studying. In these Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs),

children are given basic education, moral education and information about cleanliness,



discipline and the importance of education. Teaching is done by teachers in a simple, participatory manner and as per the needs of the children so that the educational status of children can improve and they can join school regularly. These Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) run by the organization is an important and commendable initiative towards connecting the girls of the mushar community to the mainstream of education and their all-round development.

3 days capacity building of respective staffs;

Cultural and creative activities were organized for staffs of Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) from 28th June to 30th June'2025 at Saryu Seva Sadan, Jamui. The activities like dance, paintings, songs were conducted in this program. The main objectives of this program were to develop creativity, build self-confidence and promote community participation among voluntary teachers working for community awareness and children's education. Total 50 participants were participated actively in the capacity building program.

All the participants participated in this program with enthusiasm and discipline and they were provided encouragement, guidance and support by the trainers. The training program was conducted peacefully and smoothly. At the end of training, the participants were appreciated and encouraged to join the activities related the Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) in the future. The training program was very successful and developed creative thinking, self-confidence and social participation among the participants.

Gandhi Jayanti;

Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti was celebrated at Saryu Seva Sadan, Jamui on 2nd October'2025 by all the Community Cultural Education Centers (CCECs) run by the Samagra Seva, Jamui. In this program discussions were held regarding Gandhiji's life, his thoughts and the path of truth and non-violence shown by him. During the program, creative activities like dance, song, painting etc. were organized in which children, youth and community members were participated enthusiastically. Total 60 persons were participated in this program. The special thing about this program was that all the supervisors of the organization also participated actively. The presence of all the supervisors provided guidance and inspiration to the program.

At the end of the program, all the people present together pledged to follow the path shown by Mahatma Gandhi, adopt truth and non-violence in their lives and work for the service of society. This Gandhi Jayanti program was an inspiring event which developed moral values, social responsibility and positive thinking among the participants.

Youth dialogue;

The youth awareness program was organized by the organization-Samgra Seva at Saryu Seva Sadan, Jamui on 17th October' 2025 in which 10th pass and graduate students have participated. Mrs. Shikha Roy from District Planning Office was participated in this program. She has informed children and youths about various government schemes during the program especially government scheme related to self-employment training were discussed in detail. She has informed children and youths about Kushal Yuva program (KYP), PM Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY), Pradhan Mantri Dakshta Aur Kushalta Sampanna Hitgrahi (PM-DAKSH) and these programs provide free training, certification and employment opportunities to youth in various fields.

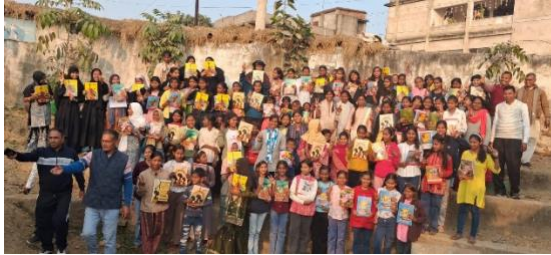


The information was given about employment and self-employment opportunities through self-employment related training. The main objective of this program was to inspire children and youth to become self-reliant. Total 60 children and youth have

participated in this program. All the participants actively participated in the program with interest. A question-answer session was also organized during the program.

Savitri Bai Fule Jayanti;

A program was organized at Saryu Seva Sadan on 3rd January' 2026 on the occasion of Savitri Bai Fule Jayanti. This program was organized with the aim of promoting girls education and making adolescent girls aware



about education and self-reliance. A large number of adolescent girls have participated enthusiastically in the program. Various cultural programs were organized on this occasion which included dance and group dance. Through their presentations, the participant highlighted the thought of Savitri Bai Fule and the importance of girls education.

Many girls told about pursuing their goals and all actively participated and made the program a success. Awareness and self-confidence towards education was developed among adolescent girls through this program.



Bhola Manjhi-cum-Education Award Ceremony;

Samagra Seva has organized the Education Award Ceremony for outstanding achievement in the field of education at Shilpa Bhawan on 26th July'2025 under the Bhola Manjhi Education Award-2025. The program was started by

lighting a lamp in which Ms. Shreyashi Singh, MLA, Sri Ritesh Kumar, Labour Superintendent, Mrs. Soni Kumari, DPO, Sri Abhinav Kumar, BDO, Mrs. Abha Kumari, CDPO, Dr. S.N. Jha, Dr. Manoj Kumar Sinha and D.D. Verma were participated.

On this occasion, Ms. Shreyashi Singh, MLA was honored by the organization by presenting her memento and cloth after being appointed as the chairman of the Bihar Stated Child Labor commission. Addressing everyone, She said that you have immense talent, there is need to recognize it and to enhance it through education. Samagra Seva is trying to bring positive changes in the society and I am ready to provide all positive support in their efforts. Describing child labour as a serious social challenge, Mr. Ritesh Kumar said that everyone's participation is necessary for its eradication. He has stressed on intensifying awareness campaigns in schools and villages.

Dr. Manoj Kumar Sinha praised the efforts of Samagra Seva to connect poor, deprived and child labour with education and said that these efforts will become the foundation of big changes in future.

Total 126 children from Mushar community were especially honored at this felicitation ceremony who left brick kiln's work and chose the path of education and today they are entering higher education.

Total 70 Prerak Didi also honored in this program who have played a vital role in re-engaging girls and women who had dropped out of school due to various reasons. Shiksha Sevaks were also honored who made significant contributions in ensuring enrolment and retention of Dalit children in schools. Sri Makeshwar Rawat, Secretary of Samagra Seva said that this award ceremony is an attempt to recognize the passion and struggle of those who are moving ahead in the field of education even in adverse circumstances. He expressed hope that this initiative will inspire more people to play their role in building the society.

International Girl's Day;

A program was organized at Sary Seva Sadan, Jamui on 11th October' 2025 on the occasion of International Girl's Day. The objectives of this program were to spread awareness about the right of girls, the importance of education and empowerment. The International Girl's Day is celebrated every year on 11th October, declared by United Nations to raise awareness about the rights of girls and the challenges they face. This day is a global occasion to promote the empowerment of girls and gender equality.



The inspiring conversations for the girls as well as cultural programs like dance, songs and drama organized in this program. Apart from this sports and creative activities were also organized in this program. At the end of program, certificates were also given to all the participants.

Girls, parents, teachers and members of the organization have participated in this program. This program fostered self-confidence and social participation among girls.

Swami Vivekanand Jayanti;

On the occasion of Swami Vivekanand Jayanti, a program was organized in two clusters- Jamui & Khaira on 12th January'2026 by Samagra Seva. The objectives of the program were to increase motivation, positive thinking and awareness among children about the importance of education. 50 children from class 8th and above were included in the program and were given information about the life and thoughts of Swami Vivekanand. The children were told

that he had emphasized on eradication of social evils, poverty and empowering women through education. He said that we should work hard until we reach our goal. Children were participated in various cultural programs. At the end of the program, all children were given notebook and pen to help them in their studies and creative activities. This program increased the enthusiasm and learning spirit among the children.

International Yoga Day;

The International Yoga Day was organized by Samagra Seva at Saryu Seva Sadan, Jamui on 21st & 22nd June'2025 in which teachers of Community Cultural Education Centers and Coaching Classes. The objectives of this program were too aware about the importance of health, mental peace and Yoga. Various types of yoga like yogasan, pranayama in this program and the benefits of it were also explained in detail. Information was given about how we can avoid diseases by exercising and it was also explained how we should adopt it in our lives. Learning was strengthened through questions-answers and group discussion and all participants were shared their experiences in this program. The enthusiasm and awareness of the participants towards yoga has increased through these two days' workshop.

Teaching Learning Materials (TLMs) Exhibition;

A special tools exhibition demonstration was organized by Samagra Seva on 31st January'2026. All respective teachers of the organization were participated enthusiastically in this program. The main objective of the Teaching Learning Materials exhibitin was how to teach difficult subjects to children of class 6th & 8th in an easy and interesting way.



The exhibition venue was decorated with colorful chart models and teaching materials. All teachers prepared their TLMs very well. A teacher created a model of multiplying and fractions for mathematics. Another teachers have had put up a chart of the human body, maps in Hindi and word cards. If children

from class 6th to 8th are taught with the help of this TLMs then children feel interested in studies due to which children started coming to the center to study and with small experiments, they got immersed in studies. Whatever subject they had found difficult earlier now seemed easy and fun to them. Children started asking questions and answering through it. In this program, all teachers of the organization felt that if the lessons are presented in the right manner, then every child can learn easily.

Textbooks distribution;

Textbooks distribution program for the children of Mushar community was organized by Samagra Seva. This program is organized regularly every year through Apna Pustakalay by the organization. Under this program, textbooks were provided to the students studying in 9th & 10th class to enable them to continue their studies smoothly. The main objective of the textbooks distribution program is to provide study material to children from economically weaker families in the Mushar community and to encourage them towards education.



Through the book distribution program, children were given information about the importance of preserving books, habit of regular study and use of library. All the children participated in the program enthusiastically. The book distribution program run by the organization through its Apna Pustakalay is a commendable initiative towards promoting the

educational development and education of children.

Coaching Class;

The Coaching Classes are being run for Dalit children in Mushar community by the organization in which children of 8th, 9th and 10th classes are taught according to their school syllabus. The Coaching Classes are being run by two or more villages together. The children of Coaching Class are taking the lead in educating younger children of their village, as a result of which the children have started attending school regularly and dropout rates have reduced and the children of Coaching Classes can perform better in the 10th examination by studying. Information about linking with skill development: children who have passed 10th class are linked to various skill programs according to their interest and ability. Under this, training programs and guidance are provided to become self-reliant in the future.

Case Story-01;

Suman Kumari daughter of Manoj Manjhi and Rubi Devi is 15 years old and lives in Chandrashaili village of Kharia block. Suman Kumari has two sisters and one brother, of which she is the eldest. There are a total of 8 members in her family. Suman's father works as a laborer in their own village and her mother works as a laborer in other's field. The financial condition is not good due to the large number of members in the family. Due to poor condition of the family, Suman has to work as a laborer in the fields. Due to small size of the house, it is difficult for everyone to live together. Despite being poor, her father has kept all his children involved in education.

After passing 8th class, Suman Kumari was enrolled in 9th class in 2024 with the help of Samagra Seva. She used attend school regularly but dropped out in 10th class because she was not registered for 10th class examination when she was in 9th class. With the help of organization's worker she was registered and filled form for 10th final examination and she was encouraged again to study regularly. Preparation for 10th examination is being done continuously from the CCECs run by the organization.

Suman Kumari wants to continue her studies and complete her studies in future and become an ANM.

Case Story-02;

Savitri Kumari daughter of Nanhuk Manjhi and Dhurpawiya Devi is 18 years old and lives in Fatehpur village of Kharia block. There are 8 members in Savitri's family, her mother is dead

and her father is old. At home, her sister-in-law makes her do all the household work, due to which she gradually stopped studying and dropped out of school after 8th class.

The Community Cultural Education Centre (CCEC) is run by the organization, one day when the organization's worker came to know about Savitri Kumari, he went to her house and counseled her brother and father. Savitri Kumari also did not want to study further but after many efforts she agreed and was enrolled in 9th class. She was weak in studies and initially came to CCEC occasionally because her sister-in-law made her work at home. After repeated counseling to her family members, she started coming regularly. She was given textbooks of 9th class by the organization.

With the support from the organization, Savitri Kumari appeared for matriculation examination in 2024 and passed with 2nd division. After this, she was enrolled in Intermediate with support from organization's worker. Due to household work, she started withdrawing from her studies again but after convincing her family, she is still studying and is going to appear for the final examination in 2026.

Savitri Kumari wants to complete her education and become an ANM or police. She says, she wants to help other children like her in their studies.
