The Integrated Unit of NAB provides after-school support through a dedicated team, serving as a resource center and bridging the gap between mainstream school teachers and visually impaired students. NAB Delhi is committed to provide all necessary facilities, including school fees, accessible books, uniforms, transportation, boarding, lodging, nutritious meals, resource classes, therapy, and more, to all beneficiaries, with the invaluable support of patrons like yourself.

NAB has partnered with <u>Project Prakash</u>, an organization that works towards the treatment of children with congenital blindness and helps them to integrate with mainstream society through education and vocational skilling. We earnestly appeal to you to consider sponsoring the annual education of 7 Project Prakash children for the academic session 2024-2025. The annual sponsorship for 1 student is **INR 1,51,200** and includes a comprehensive care of the child for 12 months. For 7 children the amount adds up to **INR 10,58,400**.
