Srujanavani Voluntary Association engages itself in creating a just society by nurturing young minds and shaping their attitudes.


Accordingly, a foray into education becomes a natural choice and cornerstone of our activities. We strive to pave the path for students and empower them to progress both individually and in society.



## Existing infrastructure


- ·Seminar hall (Accommodate 40 Students)
