

Brief proposal for the unfinished school building

We have identified an unfinished government primary school building located in the interior forest village – Nadimpalli bordering into Kadappa district. The village is from Yerravaripalayam mandal of Chittoor district, 120 Kms away from the district headquarters. The primary school is established in the year 1978 in a thatched shed constructed by the villagers (small farmers of 97 families today) collectively. After repeated representations, the government of Andhra Pradesh has sanctioned the school building in the year 2012. The contractor has taken two years to complete only roof and walls without cement plastering. He is powerful political leader and also local mafia. Even though, the school building was not completed even after two years, he has drawn all the sanctioned money from the government. This issue has come to our notice while Mr. Chennaiah has been working on the issue of wild Elephants from the forest intruding into the villages and also agricultural lands of the small farmers of 12 villages across the forest border. It is observed in the village discussion that no one has courage to expose the corruption of the school building for the fear of the criminal contractor. The neighbors of the school premises are also henchmen of the contractor. Hence they have also encroached part of the school premises and also tie up the animals after the school hours in the school premises.

It is in that stage, the villagers discussed about the protection of school premises and also completion of the school building which is very much necessity. Mr. Chennaiah has visited mandal development officer on 8th June and found that the then officials collude with the contractor to close the file without completion of the building. Even though, Mr. Chennaiah has given petition to the District Education Officer, there is no follow up from the DEO. Subsequently, the villagers started collecting donations within the village and also neighboring villages with the plan to construct the compound wall as first priority to protect the school premises (87 feet x 40 feet = 3480 SQ.feet for school and also playing) from the encroachers.

Present status of the building:

- The school is located in between households of the village. The school premises land is - 85 feet length and 45 feet width. Since there is no compound, the neighboring families occupied some portion and also night time they tie up the animals in the premises.
- The contractor cum politician is supporting the neighbors of the school not to have the compound.
- Last month – July 28th the government surveyor has demarked the school land.
- Immediately after the survey, the villagers started constructing the compound raising the resources locally.(photographs are attached)
- The school roof has been completed and the walls are constructed. There is no cement plastering is done on the walls, no windows and doors are fixed and no flooring has been done.
- The school premises after the compound wall need to put the sand, so that the children will use the place for playing.
- As of now all the 53 students and two teachers are teaching from 1st class to 5th classes within the class room (ground floor) 15 x 25 and in the varena 6 x 25 which is totally not conducive environment for learning.
- The unfinished building in the upstairs is completed, one teacher with two classes will be shifted to upstairs and front varanda part can be utilized as library.

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What is the option: If ASHA come forward to support, the following works to be undertaken:

1. Compound wall will be constructed which is in the mid way.
2. Cement wall plastering, white wash for all the old and new walls.
3. Fix the windows, doors and grills and bookshelves
4. Flooring.

The total estimated costs of the compound and to complete unfinished building is estimated Rs.839400/-. This doesn't include window, iron grills and doors which are already promised to donate by couple of government employees and the engineer from Dharani properties who come from Nadimpalli. The people will be able to offer Shramadhan collectively for the compound wall construction and also as loading labour to fill the sand in front of the school building. It comes to Rs.139400/-. They are also expected to pool down Rs.200000/- for the entire work. Therefore, the request for Rs.500000/- from ASHA.
