Prayers from SEED and its tiny tots!

SEED, founded in the year 1981, now carry on its yeomen service for the children of Life Prisoners, Victims of serious Crimes like Murder, Leprosy Patients, Victims of Natural Calamities like Tsunami, and also for other Destitute, Deserted and Socially Abandoned Children through its Mahatma Gandhi Residential Primary School – Sriperumbudur, Mahatma Residential High School – Utkottai Village and Dr J.C. Kumarappa Special & Free Industrial Training Insitute – Irungattukottai Village, mainly with the help of the benevolent and merciful financial support, received from ASHA-ST LOUIS, which was initiated by our beloved brother Mr. Sundar Swaminathan, so many years before.

Due to your support, so many boys and girls have completed their job-oriented courses in engineering, medical, agricultural fields and now, they are standing on their own feet and supporting their deprived families.

Hence, your support makes them to be self-reliant and to face the future with courage and wisdom. You have taught them to catch fish instead of giving fish through SEED's schools and ITI.

On 04.10.2023, you helped SEED by contributing your financial assistance to the tune of Rs.9,93,000/-

With the help of your financial assistance, we were able to run our Residential Primary School and Residential High School till end of February, 2025.

Due to our continuous travel to all the prisons for the admission of the children of Life Prisoners and also to the colonies for the admission of the children of Leprosy Patients and also, due to admission of the passed out children from SEED in higher education and also for searching to get financial assistance nearly

for 100 children for their higher education, we failed in our duty and moral responsibility to contact your good selves well in advance to explain everything in detail, including the Report of our Activities / Progress of the children and the Programs, for which we humbly request your good selves to kindly pardon us and forgive us for the grave mistake committed by us.

Till end of February, 2025, we were able to manage our project activities (i.e.) running our schools with the help of the balance amount of the previous year grant received from ASHA – ST LOUIS.

From March, 2025, we were find it difficult to pay the salary to the dedicated team of teachers working in our Residential Primary and Residential High School and we had diverted the money, kept for other heads of accounts, with a hope of getting your kind financial support, so that, we may replace the amount diverted from other heads of accounts, as soon as we receive your grant amount.

Since we have no balance amount in the previous grant received from ASHA – ST LOUIS after February, 2025, so far, we have spent an amount of Rs.4,91,996/- towards the salary of our Residential Primary School and Residential High School teachers, from March, 2025 to March, 2026, which was diverted from other heads of accounts with the anticipation of getting grant from ASHA – ST LOUIS and replace the same to the original heads of accounts.

Income and Expenditure Statement of our Residential Primary School and Residential High School, for which the grant is used to be received from ASHA – ST LOUIS, for the period from 1st April, 2025 to 31st March, 2026, is enclosed herewith, as an attachment to this email, for your kind perusal.

Hence, we humbly request your good selves to kindly consider our case sympathetically and favorably and extend your helping hands by contributing your MITE, to replace the amount kept for other activities of our service organization, which was already spent for our Residential Primary School & Residential High School, due to non – availability of required amount under the head of ASHA –ST LOUIS GRANT, for the period from 1st April, 2025 to 31st March, 2026.

For your kind and perusal and favorable consideration, we are submitting herewith the budget proposal for the financial year 2026 – 2027 (1st April, 2026 – 31st March, 2027).

In this regard, we would like to inform your good selves that Mr V Vinod Kumar from ASHA- HOUSTON has visited our humble service organization on 17.06.2026 and asked us to include our Residential Primary School Staff Salary in their Budget Proposal for the year 2026- 2027 towards salary of Part Time Vocational Instructors of our Residential High School and Part Salary of our Special & Free Industrial Training Institute.

Hence, we have prepared our Budget Proposal for the year 2026 -2027 only for the salary of our Residential High School staff and submitting the same to your kind perusal and favorable consideration.

We have done slight modification in the salary of the staff on the basis of their long standing dedicated and round the clock service to our less fortunate brethren.

Since, you are like parent of our service activities, kindly judge which is the best for the SEED and its children and extend your helping hands to continue our service to our socially abandoned children.

Kindly do any modifications in the Budget Proposal as you deem fit and suitable for our organization for the betterment of the children and the staff and SEED as a whole.
