## **RECENT DEVELOPMENTS:**

- Our Mahatma Gandhi Residential Primary School at Sriperumbudur got 'A' Grade in implementing "EDUCATION FOR ALL" Scheme (SARVA SIKSHA ABHIYAN) among 125 Primary Schools in Sriperumbudur Range.

  Prisoners) and we took our children to all the 9 Central Prisons of the State to perform
  the programme which was appreciated by the large number of audience (Prisoners)
  and the Superintendent of the respective prisons.
- Some of our children had an opportunity to meet and interact with His Excellency Dr.
   A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, former President of India and interact with him in a 'SPECIAL
   MEET' organized only for the children studying in Government Schools and Destitute
   Children Homes.
- Students of our Special and Free Industrial Training Institute took part in the District Level Sports Meet and won 1<sup>st</sup> Prize in 'Jawalin Throw', 1<sup>st</sup> Prize in 800 Metre Running and Runner in Volley Ball and they prepare themselves for the forthcoming State Level Sports Meet.
- Our Sriperumbudur has completed all the formalities to get registration as 'FIT' Institution by the Department of Social Defence which is the Prime Requisite of the Government to run a Home for the Children in of Care and Protection.
- School Final Year (S.S.L.C.) children of Sriperumbudur and Utkottaicentres are writing their Government Public Examination with their hard work and with an intention of getting 100% result in all the subjects.

 One of our students, whose father was a LIFE PRISONER in MADURAI CENTRAL PRISON, secured 436/500 in his S.S.L.C. Public Examination and got admission in VIDYAA VIKAS HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL, GANDHARVAKKOTTAI (nearPudukottai), which is a renouned educational institution in the State. Recently, we received a good news from him that he secured 200/200 in Biology Examination which paves the way for his admission in Medical College which is also the dream of this cleaver boy.
