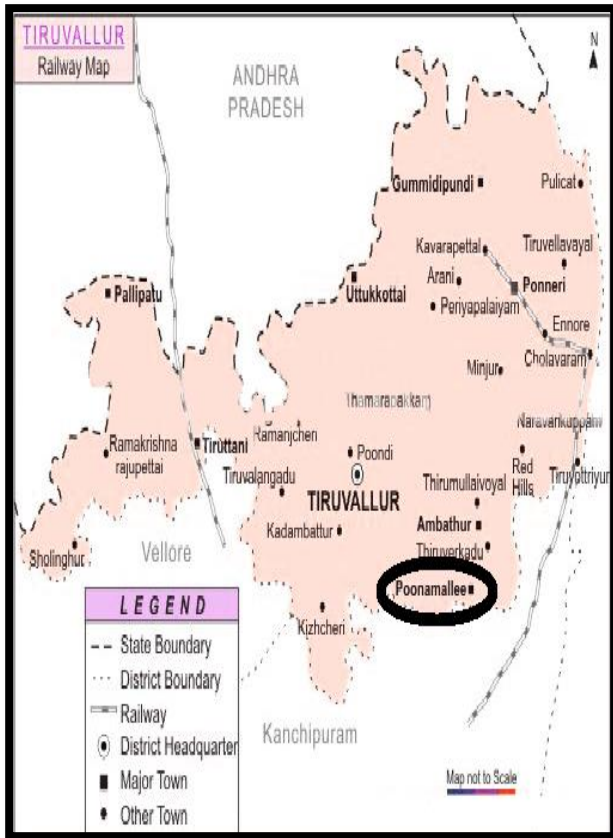
The objectives of 'SEED' are:

At present, **SEED's** projects are located in three Centres, namely. **Sriperumbudur & Irungattukottai** at Kancheepuram Disitric, and **Utkottai** at Thiruvallur District in the State of **TAMIL NADU, INDIA**.

III. TARGETTED GROUP :

‘ SEED ’ is focussing mainly on the CHILDREN of LIFE PRISONERS, VICTIMS OF SERIOUS CRIMES LIKE MURDER, LEPROSY PATIENTS & VICTIMS OF NATURAL CALAMITIES.

Due to social stigma, the children of Life Prisoners are excluded by the society after the imprisonment of the bread winner of the family (father or mother) .

‘ SEED ’ firmly believes that the children of Prisoners, should not be punished because of the offence committed by their parents. ‘ SEED ’ also believes that no one in the world born as criminal. Environment / circumstance in which they are brought up, has only made them as good or bad. If we change the environment/circumstance as good, then each and every child will become good. In the same manner, children of Victims of Serious Crimes like Murder will take a revenge against the people who killed their parents. Hence, they have been brought in a changed environment and they have also been taken care of by ‘ SEED ’ in a healthy atmosphere to forget the past and march towards their better future.

In the case of Leprosy Patients also, children are accompanied with their parents while the parents are going for begging to earn their livelihood, which will make the children also to beg with their parents. Hence, the change of atmosphere, available at ‘ SEED ’ brings a change in the lives of the children of Leprosy Patients, too, by removing the thoughts of begging from their minds. Children from natural calamities are used to forget their sorrows and sufferings in ‘ SEED ’ by mingling with the other children and lead a new life .

How ‘ SEED ’ brings change in the lives of the children from vulnerable sector of our Society ?

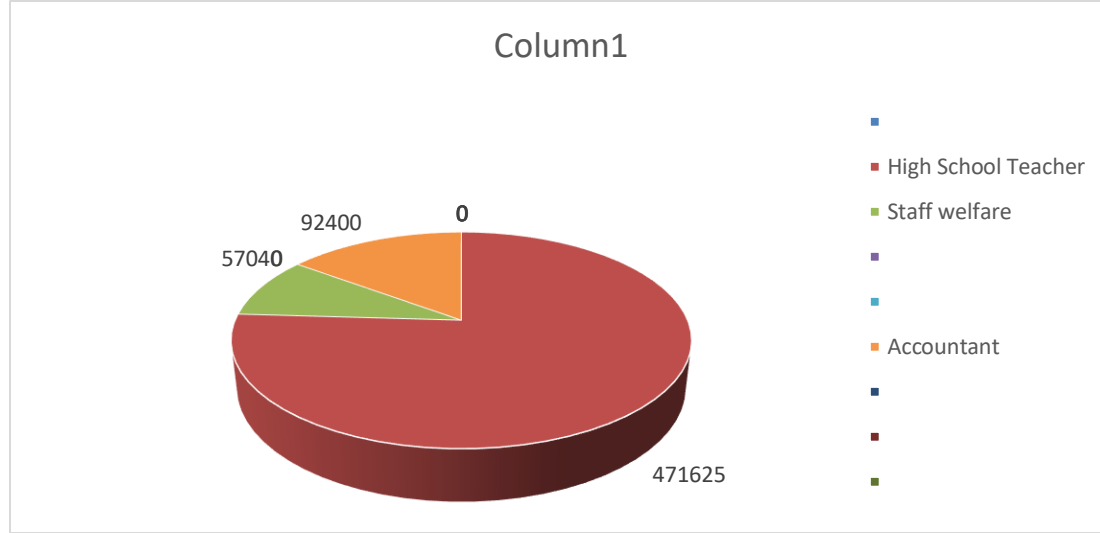
