<u>Sub.</u>:- Request for 'ONE TIME GRANT 'to provide certain amenities to the children of SEED, staying and studying in Residential Primary School, run by SEED at FREE OF COST.

Prayers!

Thank you very much for your kind support to run our Residential Primary School and Residential High School at <u>FREE OF COST</u> for the welfare of the children of Life Prisoners, Victims of Serious Crimes like Murder, Leprosy Patients, Tsunami Victims and also for the destitute, deserted and socially abandoned children.

Even though, you are helping us to fulfill the recurring needs of the institutions run for our less fortunate brethren, we are having certain non-recurring needs of our organization which require <u>ONE TIME GRANT</u>. If we fulfill these needs, we may satisfy the basis needs of our children those who are in – need of – care and protection and also of our institutions.

Our projectwise requirements, which are non-recurring in nature, are described in the following few lines with justification of the needs for your kind perusal and favourable consideration:

JUSTIFICATION FOR THE ABOVE MENTIONED NEEDS FOR OUR MAHATMA GANDHI RESIDENTIAL PRIMARY SCHOOL AT OUR SRIPERUMBUDUR CENTRE:

i) <u>Tables, Chairs, Cub Boards, Sitting and Writing Benches</u>:

- At present, we are not having proper tables, chairs & cub boards for the teachers, rendering service in our Sriperumbudur Centre. If we provide the same to them, they will do their service comfortably and keep their respective class's books, note books, registers, charts, teaching aids and other useful materials for their teaching safely in the cub boards, allotted to them.
- At our Sriperumbudur Centre, we are having boys upto 10 years and girls upto 18 years (staying in SEED studying in the Government Girls' Higher Secondary School) for whom we are not having proper Sitting Benches and Writing Benches. If we have atleast 21 sitting

and writing benches, we may make use of the same for class rooms for the children studying in 4th and 5th standards during class hours. The same class room furniture may be used for high school girls during their morning and evening study hours.

ii) Computers, Computer Tables & Chairs:

• At our Sriperumbudur Centre, we are having a Computer Class Room for the children of our Mahatma Gandhi Primary School for which DELL Computer Company donated 5 computers. We are offering computer education to all the children of Sriperumbudur Centre starting from 1st Standard. But the existing computers are not enough to provide proper computer education to all the children of this centre. If we have 10 more computers with tables and chairs, we may impart computer education to the primary school children during their school hours and also to the elder girls in evening hours after they return from their school and also for few hours during their holidays.

iii) Science Equipments:

• After implementation of "EDUCATION FOR ALL" (SARVA SIKHSHA ABHIYAN) Programme by the Government in all the Primary Schools, our Mahatma Gandhi Primary School has got 'A' Grade in implementation of this scheme. In the modern scientific world, each and every child should be given an opportunity to have upto date knowledge in the science and technology and the new innovations and inventions in science and research. The Primary School children should also have atleast a minimum knowledge in science and the latest developments happened in science and technology for which we require certain equipments such as models of human Skelton, heart, eye, ear, nose and other parts of

human body and also some simple apparatus for physics and chemistry so that they may acquire certain knowledge in the basic science for which we have to procure simple and basic models and apparatus in physics, chemistry and biological science for which we require an amount of Rs.50,000/-.

iv) DINNING HALL CONSTRUCTION:

 At present, children of our Sriperumbudur are using their dormitory of one of the four houses as their dinning hall which makes lot of inconvenience for all the children. Some time this dormitory may not enough to accommodate all the children. More over, the same dormitory is used as class room for one class in the Primary School in day time and sleeping place in night time. As soon as the children are taking meals, it will take long time to clean the place with water and dry it and make use of the same for class room purpose or sleeping purpose because the tiny tots of this centre have made their eating place as soppy with dhall, side dish, sambar, butter milk and other items. (Children are always children). If we have separate hall for dining purpose, the above mentioned inconvenience, such as soppiness and lack of accommodation for all children during dinning time, will not occur. More over, the same dinning hall may be used as Prayer Hall and Meeting Hall to conduct Students' Literary Association Meetings during week ends and also to conduct staff meetings and Students' Parliament Meeting on the regular interval of time.

Hence, we require a DINNING HALL for our Mahatma Gandhi Residential Primary School at our Sriperumbudur Centre for which we have estimated an amount of Rs.10,00,000/- required.

OUR PLEA:

We have mentioned our ONE TIME requirements in the above mentioned few lines. You have already helped us to run our Primary and High School programmes successfully for the welfare of our under privileged children. Now, we are again standing near your door steps to fulfill certain important needs of SEED.

Please consider our request sympathetically and favourably and accord your kind sanction to proceed further in this regards.

If our estimation seems to be high, kindly help us to your possible extent, atleast to fulfill certain needs of SEED's children as the mother helps her child to fulfill his needs.

Estimation and other relevant documents will be submitted to your good selves as soon as we hear your positive words.
