We follow the pattern of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (education for all project of India). The teachers are trained under this pattern and educational materials are supplied by the department of education. The day care center is focusing on preparing the children to admit them in the First standard. The transit school children for dropouts and child workers prepares them for streamlining them in formal system of education. The supportive education in the evening session strengthen their education by focussing them in their school lessons. Children are given orientation and training in their school lessons so that they can be prevented from dropping out from school. _

- To mainstream all children in formal system of education
- To strengthen the supportive education
- Encourage them in extra curricular activities
- To prepare them for career awareness and orient them for vocational skills and future plan of their training and education
- To render services in panchayat school for counseling and health services

Description of current school facilities (building, equipment etc) _____

The present welfare center constitute a crèche, transit school, and supportive education classes. In addition we conduct training for nursing assistant and offer health services to the community. ____

How do you need to improve these facilities?

- We need to have a separate room for day care center.
- We need to have an additional room for day care center for pre school children. for 600 sqft with toilet facilities for 25 to 30 children_____

How do you think the school has improved in the last year?

We have strengthened the services of supportive education in the evening session from 25 children to 120 children.. We organized extracurricular activities like competition and field trips and picnics. We celebrated community festival like pongal and Navarathri celebrations by involving parents of the children. _____

What are the problems you have faced in the last year? _____

We need to improve the panchayat school campus by providing them with toilet facilities and furniture and when we enroll the children in the community school official expect them to provide them with

uniforms and some furniture for the school . We need to have awareness programme in the community to prevent them from further dropout and also expect some extra curricular activities for children _____

How would you rate the overall effectiveness of this project over the past year?

Our project is successful as the number of school going children is increasing with their parents involvement. . Due to the distance of the panchayat school from the crushers we were going and picking up the children to study in our centre. Gradually as the number increased the parents wanted a school near their workspot. This has made the Governemnt to start a Single teacher school _____

How much longer do you foresee requiring Asha funding, and for what purposes?

We are very thankful for the support rendered by Asha. Our work involves interacting with quarry workers and this is a vulnerable area to be tackled. We need your support for another five years. _____
