

## **A Brief Report on Jeevan Sadhana Vidya Niketan (JSVN) Schools, 2017.**

### **Shanti Sadhana Ashram, Basistha, Guwahati -781029, Assam, India.**

- 1. Name of Schools and Strength of Students:** Jeevan Sadhana Vidya Niketan Schools, Basistha, Guwahati, Assam, India, have the following student strength against each school.

- 2. Participation of Shanti Sadhana Ashram in School Activities:** SSA, Basistha, Guwahati, Assam, India has played yeoman role in managing the JSVN Schools. It also rendered services for the smooth running of the JSVN Schools activities, development of paraphernalia and tried hard to manage fund from different agencies. The SSA authority is responsible for the overall management of 4 schools and had good rapport with the management committees of the respective JSVN schools.

**3. Participation of Assam Development Initiative Society (AIDS), Guwahati:** The Assam Development Initiative (ADI) - a non-profit non-Govt. organization is doing its best for the development of JSVN Schools. A bridge on the rivulet at the gate of the Dharbam school was constructed at a cost of Rs55000.00. The amount was met from the donation given by Er Hiren Sarma-an USA based ADI member. Previously, makeshift arrangement was made by bamboo every year to cross the rivulet. It was actually very dangerous for the students in crossing the rivulet while going to school. This is an excellent arrangement and we are highly thankful to Er Hiren Sarma.

**4. TEACHERS'TRAINING:** The school Management Committee, as earlier, decided to provide training to the JSVN Schools Teachers during the summer vacation. In this connection, authority has contacted a few trained teachers to be the Resource Person and got response from Ms Niru Basumatary, Guwahati and Ms Sugandhi Sadhanidar, Sibsagar. The

committee requested Er M N D Bordoloi, Retired Chief Chemist, Namrup Ferti-chem; Dr T C Sarma, Retired Scientist of CSIR NEIST, Jorhat and Sri Hembhai, Noted Educationist and Writer to be the Resource persons for the summer training. The training was held during 10 to 17 July 2017 at SSA campus, Basistha. All the teachers were invited for the training and attended the programme. The training was held for 8 days.

**5. Youth Classes for Yoga:** During June 2017, SSA arranged a Youth Classes for undergoing training on Yoga. More than 150 Youths took part from different schools including JSVN Schools. There were two shifts in morning time. The two shifts were- Morning 5 to 6 AM and 6 to 7 AM. Ms Champa Deka, member SSA, took the leadership in this training. There will be Yoga classes in JSVN Schools in every Saturday from January 2018.

**6. Radio Programme:** The FM Radio-95, Guwahati has a day long programme with our school children on 14.10.2017. The students from the JSVN, Basistha School only. Basistha School students performed very nicely. They performed drama, dance, song and mono-acting. School teachers also took part in the programme by singing songs and answering the questions asked by the FM Radio persons. The authority of FM Radio was highly satisfied with the performance.

**7. School renovation/repairing works at Robingaon & Pachim Killing:** ASHA for Education, USA is kind enough in funding for the repairing/renovation works to be done in Robingaon and Pachim Killing JSVN Schools. Works, in both the schools, was started during December 2017 and hope to complete within two months time.

**8. Local Guardian's Interview taken on schools:** As per the instruction from ASHA, USA, we have taken interview to some guardian and local elders regarding the presence of the JSVN schools in their locality. Video recording will be sent on due time along with the repairing photographs of the two schools. Name of guardians and local elders will also be sent separately.

**9. Extra-curricular Activities:** During November 20 to 25, 2017 Sport week was observed in all the schools. Various games and other related activities were performed among the students. All the winners were given prizes and every student got consolation prizes. Social activities were also done like "Chacha Bharat Abhizan", observing Republic Day, Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti etc. Saraswati Puja was celebrated in a grand way.

**10. SC/ST Students:** More than 90% of the students belong to SC/ST and living below poverty line. They are mostly belonging to daily wage earner, thela and rickshaw pullers and very marginal agriculturist.

**11. Payment of Remuneration to Staff:** We are highly thankful to ASHA for Education, USA and ADI, Guwahati for the grant for which the payment of Remuneration to the staff was regular. Remuneration was also increased two-fold.

**12. Examination & Result:** All the examinations were held regularly and results were communicated to the students as well as to the parents. Annual examination was also held during last week of November to first week of December 2017. Results were declared on 28 December 2017. The students, who left our schools after class VI or VIII, are also showing exemplary results in their respective schools, where they got admitted.

**13. Fund Received:** During the Financial year 2017April – 2018 March(till January2018), we received Rs 5.0 lakhs from ASHA on 05.07.2017, Rs 1.52 lakhs from ASHA on 15.12.2017 (Total Rs 6.52 lakhs) for JSVN Schools and Rs 4.23 lakhs from ASHA for repairing/renovation works of Robingaon and P.Killing schools. Rests of the expenditure of JSVN schools are being met by SSA, Basistha. The amount will be communicated after auditing the accounts.

**14. Budget for 2018-2019:** The budget for JSVN Schools for the session from April 2018 to March 2019 is given below for kind approval and sanction. The budgetary amount will be required from 1<sup>st</sup> of April 2018 to March 2019. ASHA for Education, USA will be appreciated for kind sanction in time to manage the school activities smoothly.
