

A Brief Report on Jeevan Sadhana Vidya Niketan (JSVN) Schools, 2018.

2. **Participation of Shanti Sadhana Ashram in School Activities:** The role played by SSA, Basistha, Guwahati, Assam, India has been counted for the managing of JSVN Schools. It also rendered services for the smooth running of the JSVN School activities, development of paraphernalia and tried hard to manage fund from different agencies. The SSA authority is responsible for the overall development of 4 schools and had good rapport with the local managing committees of the respective JSVN schools.

3. **A. Participation of Assam Development Initiative (ADI), Guwahati:** We are proud to account the presence of Assam Development Initiative, Guwahati in the developmental activities carried out at the JSVN Schools. The Assam Development Initiative (ADI) - a non-profitting non-Govt. organization is doing its best for the development of JSVN Schools. A bridge on the rivulet at the gate of the Dharbam School was constructed at a cost of Rs 55000.00. The amount was met from the donation given by Er Hiren Sarma-an USA based ADI member and a faithful well wisher of these schools. Previously, makeshift arrangement was made by Bamboo Bridge every year to cross the rivulet. It was actually very dangerous for the students in crossing the rivulet while coming to school. This is an excellent arrangement and we are highly thankful to Er Hiren Sarma for his kind donation as well as Mr R K Bhuyan, who took the burden of construction.

B. ASHA, USA: ASHA for Education, USA and ADI tried hard to do something to the JSVN schools, particularly Robingaon and Pachim Killing. On our request, ASHA-USA provided Rs6, 62,000.00 for renovation/repairing of Robingaon and Pachim Killing schools. C.I. sheets of both the school

buildings were changed with new ones. Doors and windows were repaired/changed. In the two schools Lavatory for girls and boys were provided. Schools building were connected with water systems in required places. Floor of these schools were made pucca. Boundary fencing provided with the old C.I. sheets in P.Killing school. We are highly thankful to ASHA, USA for financial help.

C. PRIYABANDHU, Guwahati: PRIYABANDHU- An NGO based at Guwahati is now connected with the developmental activities of JSVN Schools. On 22nd November, a good number of members from Priyabandhu visited JSVN School-Pachim Killing along with members from ADI. Priyabandhu provided quite a large number of school items like-school bags, water bottle, pencil box etc. to the students. We are highly thankful to Priyabandhu.

- 4. TEACHERS'TRAINING:** The school Management Committee, as earlier, decided to provide training to the JSVN School Teachers during the summer vacation. In this connection, authority has contacted a few experience trained teachers to be the Resource Person. The training was held during 10 to 19 July 2018 at SSA campus, Basistha. All the teachers were invited for the training. Most of the teachers attended the programme. The training was held for 10 days.
- 5. Yuva Classes for Yoga:** During June 2018, SSA arranged a Yuva Classes for undergoing training on Yoga. More than 150 Youths took part from different schools including JSVN Schools. There were two shifts only in morning time. The two shifts were-Morning 5 to 6 AM and 6 to 7 AM. Ms Champa Deka from SSA took the leadership in this training. The Yoga classes were followed by Naturopathy-based on natural medicine.
- 6. Local Guardian's Interview taken on schools:** As per the instruction from ASHA, USA, we have taken interview of some guardian and local elders regarding the presence of the JSVN schools in their locality. The reaction of the village elders/guardians was highly positive. They felt that these schools are boon to their localities in spreading education among the children of down-trodden section of the society in such remote areas of the state.
- 7. Extra-curricular Activities:** During November 19 to 24, 2018, Sport week was observed in all the schools. Various games and other related activities were performed among the students. All the winners were given prizes and every student got consolation prizes. Social activities were also done like "Chacha Bharat Abhizan", observing Republic Day, Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti etc. Saraswati Puja was celebrated in a grand way.
- 8. SC/ST Students:** More than 90% of the students belong to SC/ST and are living below poverty line. They are mostly belonging to daily wage earner, thela and rickshaw pullers and very marginal agriculturist. We have not taken any fee from the students.

9. Payment of Remuneration to Staff: We are highly thankful to ASHA, USA for the grant for which the payment of Remuneration to the staff was regular. Remuneration was also increased.

10. Examination & Result: All the examination was held regularly and results were communicated to the students as well as to the parents. Annual examination was also held during last week of November to first week of December 2018. Results were declared on 27th December 2018. The students, who left our schools after class VIII, are also showing exemplary results in their respective schools, where they got admitted.

11. Fund Received: During the Financial year April 2018– March 2019, we received Rs 5.0 lakhs on 29.06.2018 and Rs1.53 lakhs on 29.11.2018 from ASHA (Total Rs 6.53 lakhs) for teacher's remuneration. Rests of the expenditure of JSVN schools are being met by SSA, Basistha.

12. Budget for 2019-2020: The budget for the session from April 2019 to March 2020 is given below for kind approval and sanction.
