- 2. Participation of Shanti Sadhana Ashram (SSA), Basistha in School Activities:** Shanti Sadhana Ashram, Assam has rendered services for smooth running of the JSVN school activities, development of paraphernalia and tried hard to manage fund from different agencies.
- 3. Participation of Assam Development Initiative Society (ADIS), Guwahati:** The ADIS Guwahati is trying its level best to garner fund from different sources and also its own. Er Hiren Sarma, an USA based member of ADIS has donated School Uniform to the remote areas schools- Robingaon , Paschim Killing and Dharbam spending Rs 50100.00. We are highly thankful to him. ADIS also provides free slates, pencils, copy books, drawing books, drawing materials, play materials, game materials, and exhibition materials like drawing sheets, gums, sand papers etc. Ms Dipali Dutta Bordoloi , retired professor of Namrup college, Assam has donated her self – written Rhyme book numbering 200 copies for free distribution among the students of 4 schools. We are grateful to her.
- 4. Participation of Rotary Club, Guwahati:** Rotary club of Guwahati has offered technical assistance in maintaining the water system at Dharbam. We are thankful to the club.
- 5. Greening the School Campus:** In view of greening the school campus, we are taking a plantation programme with the help of Rotary Club of Guwahati, Assam Development Initiative society, Guwahati and local people of respective schools near to the area in Basistha, Dharbam and Robingaon Schools. Most of the saplings planted were fruit bearing plants.
- 6. Student Strenght :** During the year 2015, the enrolment in most of the schools was poor. However, this year (2016) the total strength is increased to 319.
- 7. Teacher's Training:** A special training programme was organized with the help of ADIS, Guwahati on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2016 at Basistha. All the teacher participated in this programme. The training camp was inaugurated b Er Biswadip Barooah, President of ADIS. He has given emphasis on the all-round development of both teachers and

students for ameliorating excellent education /teaching and also moral and physical development of the students in particular .Er MND Bordoloi , Member ADIS; Mrs Dipali Dutta Bordoloi, retired professor of Namrup college and Mrs Surabhi Barooah, Montessori trained teacher from Marias Public School , Guwahati acted as resource persons. They are well experience in the field of education/teaching and given the training in a homely atmosphere. They also discussed about the facilities to be provided to the students – such as training kits, sports & games and other amenities. Teachers were highly benefitted from the training. Dr T C Sarma, coordinator of JSVN Schools and Secretary ADIS coordinated the programme. Refreshment was provided from Shanti Sadhana Ashram, Basistha .

8. **Fund Received :** JSVN Schools received fund from : 1. ASHA for Education, USA Rs 4.85 lac and Rs 65000.00 Total Rs 5.50 lac & 2. Er Hiren Sarma, USA Rs 50100.00 (Donated School Uniform) during 2016-2017 session. Shanti Sadhana Ashram, Basistha also rendering substantial help by providing man and materials in running the schools. Seva, Sahyog, Samarpan Group of Guwahati had donated Rs 3200.00 and Exercise Books, Pencils, Food materials etc. on Republic Day (2016). We are thankful to the organization.
9. **Free distribution of books:** New and Old Books were distributed free Among the students and trying to get more books from other sources also.
10. **Supply of Uniform:** Uniforms were supplied to the students of 3 schools – Robingaon, Pachim killing and Dharbam. Uniforms were donated by Er Hiren Sarma. Basistha School is already having uniform for the students.
11. **Performance of Schools:** The Results of the outgoing students, who were admitted in the higher classes in different schools are excellent. The general results of each classes are also very good. In case of sports and other extracurricular activities, our students brought laurels in National Events. A girl from our school becomes 2<sup>nd</sup> in Yoga amongst the competitor of Assam. The camp was organized by Kamakhya Yuva Bikash Kendra, Guwahati, Assam. Four of our outgoing students got 1<sup>st</sup> division with Distinction in HSLC Examination.
12. **Art Competition:** ADIS, Guwahati arranged an Art Competition on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2016 (Republic Day of India), in all the 4 schools. More than 150 students participated in the competition. There were 3 Groups and 3 Themes. Gr-I (Nursery to Class II): Flower/ Fruit; Gr – II (Class III – Class V): Bird/ Animal and Gr – III (Class VI – Class VIII); Scener. Ms U Phukan , Member of ADIS, Coordinated the Programme. Prizes were distributed to the winners at function, where local people and guardian were present.
