

## SITE VISIT REPORT

### Introduction

Tribal Empowerment public school started since 2004, by Asha Darshan in collaboration with Asha For Education.

### Name of the School and Location:

Tribal Empowerment public school. Village: Leingangching, PO: Litan, District Ukhrul, Manipur and provides crucial source of primary and middle class education to over 512 student.

### Findings:

1. Half yearly examination was going on the day we visited the school. Subject of the examination was Moral science. Students answered almost all the questions.
2. Quality of education is very good. So far ninety three students from the school qualified entrance test for enrolment in class VI conducted by JNV. Year wise records of qualified candidates mentioned in the table below.

Requirements:

- Last year the Asha For Education financial assistance helped begin School repairing. The school require additional fund to complete the repairing works.

- Existing toilet is at a down place, very slippery in the heavy rains, and mud sliding incidences are very common in the region. So construction of a new toilet at a high place is essential which will be useful for boys and girls separately. At least 3 toilets.

Water source is nearby, but not drinkable directly because of mud water. After filtering people use it but the school has no water filter facility. So it is recommendable to support water filter.
