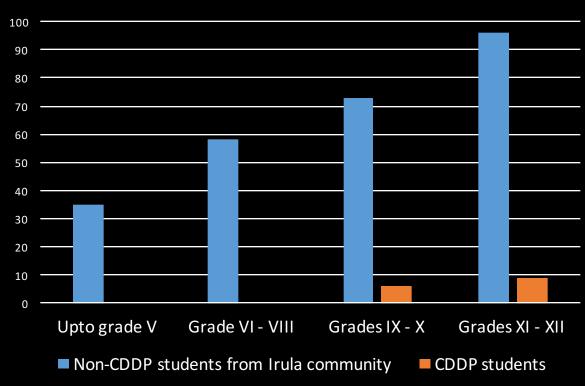

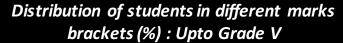

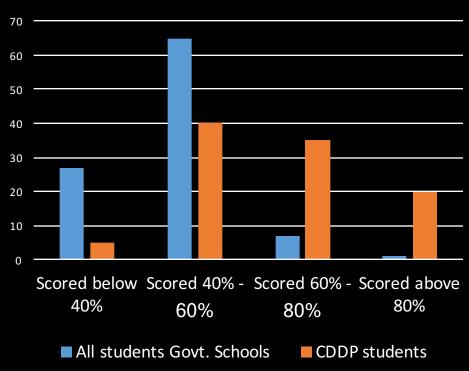
## Drop-out rate: CDDP School students vs. other Irula children

#### School dropout rate among Irula children (%)

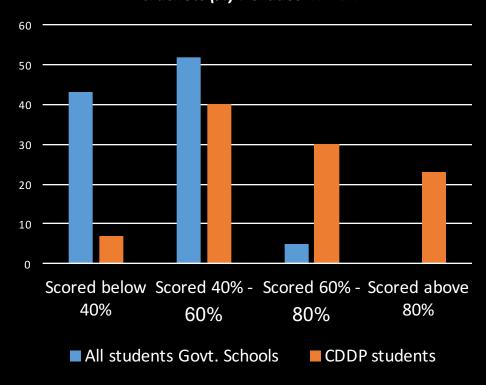


## Marks obtained: CDDP School students vs. all Govt. school students

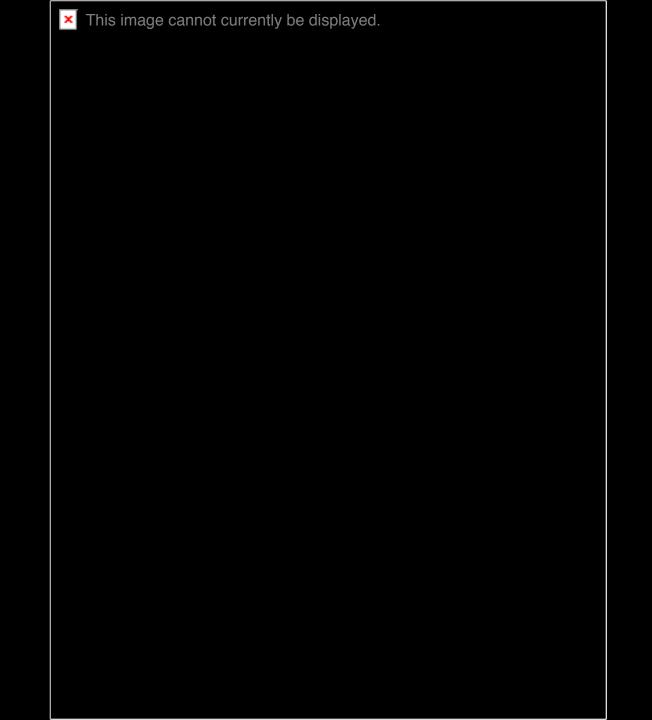
