

**Annal Progress Report of Education Programme-2022-2023**  
**Sponsored By-ASHA FOR EDUCATION (SV)**  
**Voluntary Association for Rural Upliftment & Networking (VARUN)**  
**Session-April-2022 to March-2023**

VARUN is a social and non-profit organisation which works for poor and deprived forest dwellers living in remote forest villages of Naugarh block of Chandauli district and Nagawa block of Sonebhadra district in U.P. The main objective of the VARUN is to empower socially and economically marginalized people in getting all round development so as to take part in the nation's main stream of development and progress. In order to achieve this objective, VARUN primarily focuses on Child Education. Accordingly we operate an educational centre in those forest villages which have no educational amenities.

Besides the education, we help the people for economic betterment through organic grain and vegetable cultivation, animal husbandry and creating additional employment opportunities through MNREGA –a nationwide employment programme of the government. We also work for health and hygiene, malnutrition, vaccination, safe maternity, eradication of malaria and typhoids with the government health department as hand in gloves. Women empowerment, higher education and other social issues are attempted depending upon requirements of the communities.

**OUR PROGRAMMES –**

1. **Child Education Centers-** Like last year, this year also a total of 11 learning centres are operating combindly in the Naugarh block in Chandauli district and Nagwa block of Sonebhadra district. This year, at the beginning of session 2022-2023 a total of 366 students were already enrolled on 1st April, which increased to 402 at the end of April. A total of 433 students have been enrolled till the end of March 2023 ( See table 1 & tables 2)

It is clearly visible from the table-1 that girls enrollment is achieved more as compared to the boys. Besides, most of the teachers perform better than that of boys so for sincerely home works and discipline is concerned. This is also when most of the girl students help their mothers in the household chores.

**Birthday celebration of students** : During year a total of 242 birth celebration of the student have been organised including all education centres. Maximum birth celebration were made during the year. On such occasion concerned students are gifted with notebook, pencil, pencil box, which chocolates and biscuits are distributed among the remaining students. This activity motivates the students to come to school regularly.

A details of various activities are given as under-

**1.Staff Meeting-** Under the staff meeting at least 15 meeting is held in a year at Naugarh office. In this meeting information related to the progress of various activities going on in the villages are gathered and compiled for future analysis. Simultaneously, each activity is discussed minutaly with teachers and field motivators to come with an effective ways for implementation in next months. Since these strategies are formulated through collective discussion of teachers and motivators, the project activities are implemented effectively in the villages.

**2.Jan Sampark-** In order to maintain quality in education and health. Jan sampark are done by the concerned teacher by roaming in the village and almost every

parent is contacted. Information is obtained the concerned parent about any problem related to the children education and health and their views are taken to solve the problem..

**3)-Door to door visit-** In order to know the status of home study, family health and agriculture, teachers visits the every house of the village.

**4.Evaluation of Education Centres-** Education centres are regularly evaluated by the coordinator, community motivator and field assistant. During the visit to centre, physical conditions of the centre improvement in reading & writing skill of the children and class works are evaluated. School level problems, if any, are discussed with the teachers.

**5.Mass Meeting-** Under this activity all the villagers are gathered and issues related with education and Govt. Schemes are discussed by the coordinator and field/staff. Information regarding new govt. Schemes are shared with the villagers and they are motivated to take advantages of the schemes.

**6.Examination test-** Monthly, quarterly, half yearly and annual test are conducted by the teachers on a presented dates for the school, to evaluation the progress in the skills of the children based on the performance standareds, children are promoted to the higher classes.

**8-Important day celebration:-**Important day like International health day, Ambedker Jayanti, May Day, Enviornment day, Yoga day, Independence day, Teacher day is celebrated on 07 & 14 April, 01 May, 05 & 21 June, 15 August & 05 September 2022. Teachers are informed about the day to be celebrated in the monthly teacher's meeting.

**9- Awareness Programmes-** Teachers of all the project villages were instructed to visit the every household of the respective village and aware the people regarding education and corona pandemic. The people are being informed about the preventive measures of corona virus.

**10-Home Education-** Frequent discussion is made with parents of the students regarding continuation of home education until the education centres reopend. Students are contacted every household by the teachers. During the month all the children enrolled as students have been covered under this activity and necessary

guidance was given. Learning materials were distributed among enrolled students at the concerned home. Preparation of note books was completed from 1st to 8<sup>th</sup> classes in the concerned education centre.

**Cultural Programme**  
**Naugarh, Chandauli & Nagwa, Sonebhadra**  
**Session-2022-2023**

In order to develop sports spirits and awareness about their culture among the children. Sports and cultural activities were organized 5 project in villages of Sonebhadra and six villages of Chandauli district on various occasion in January 2023. On the 9th January this programme was organized in Viranchuva & Nandana of Nagawa block of Sonebhadra with 45 and 34 participants including children, teachers and guardian. Similarly a program was organized on 11th & 12th Jan.2023 in Shahpur and Bhaganda with 84 and 42 participants, on 13th Jan.2023 in Jhariyawan and Nauvanar with 40 & 56 participants, on 18th Jan. 2023 in Aurawantand & Dhobahi with 44 & 38 participants, on 19th Jan.2023 in Duwari with 80 participants while 20th January 2023 in Sidhawabhat & Vankheta with 35 & 42 participants. Activities covered in programs were Math & general knowledge, fine arts, essay, song & chair race and children's having high attendance was given prize. Prize for winners were given from hands of foremost old aged of the concerned project village. Guardian were also participated activities in the program's.

### **Drinking water-2022-2023**

In order to ensure clean and pure drinking water in some project villages in the area, a proposal was sent to Asha for Education for setting up hand pumps in 5 villages. Due to the availability of drinking water facility in one of these 5 villages, the hand pump of this village has been installed in the girls hostel under construction. Out of the remaining 4 centres village, hand pumps have been installed in 3 centre villages while hand pump will be installed by April to May 2023 in Aurawantand centre village.

#### **Details of Drinking Water Pump**

The working of boring of hand pumps has been completed in three centres i.e. Nauvanar, Jhariyawan and Dhobahi including compound of hostel at Naugarh. Water pump installation work has been done in all three centres. Boring work has been done at Naugarh hostel.

#### **Details of drinking water availability at Bhaganda Centre**

So for education centre at Bhaganda is concerned, This education centre is located in Bihar state where drinking water is being supplied to the villagers by the Bihar government by installing overhead tanks. In this sequence, a connection has been taken from the tank to ensure the availability of drinking water for the children as the water pump boring work has not been done at the concerned education centre.

#### **Details of boring in compound of Naugarh Hostel**

As for as Naugarh hostel is concerned, boundary wall of compound (hostel work) being constructed for the construction of hostel work has been completed. The boring work for drinking water has been completed.

### Health Programmes-2022-2023

Students as well as respective parents are taking benefits of **FIRST AID BOX** kept at each school to meet emergency health needs. The First Aid Boxes consist of general medicines like paracetamol, albendazole, perinorm, Zinc sulphate, metrogyl, belargan, folic acid, chlorine, anticeptic ointment, povidine and betadine ointment with cotton, spirit and bandage. Contraceptives too are made available to the desirous persons with advice about advantages of family planning. People are also motivated to take benefits of ambulance services of **dial 102 and 108** as per need.
