Additional Grant Demand for Girl's Hostel against excessive Expenditure_

Varun received a total of Rs.47,30,000 in three installments from Asha For Education for the construction of the girl's hostel at Naugarh, Chandauli. The work done in the first installment incurred an additional expenditure of Rs. 52,409 after

which a total of Rs.20 lakh was received in the form of the second installment in which an additional expenditure of Rs. 71,300 was incurred. In addition Rs 12 lakh was received as the third installment but in this also there was an excess expenditure of Rs 13,26,056.00 Thus, after the payment of all three installments, the total additional expenditure is Rs 13,07,165 which has still pending to be paid to different merchant. Need of Contribution from Asha for Education for running of Girl's Hostel at Naugarh

As a complete proposal has already been sent to "Asha For Education" to run the hostel established in Naugarh, Chandauli.

For the operation of the hostel, a demand of Rs 9,47,900 has been made for non-recurring heads while Rs 18,85,800 for recurring heads in opening year.

Details of Estimated Expenditure is being sent herewith for your kind consideration.

With 10 % increase in the expenditures of Girl's Hostel can be operated in future with a cost around Rs.21-22lakh annually.

"Initiating a hostel for the girls belonging from marginalised families of the Naugarh block (Chandauli) and Nagwa block (Sonebhadra), UP (India)"

By- Voluntary Association for Rural Upliftment and Networking (VARUN)

Initiating a girl's hostel in Naugarh block of Chandauli district will prove to be a boon for those girls which are coming from deprived families and had strong desire to get higher education. As these girls are resides in remotely located forest village with poor communicability and mobility which suppress their desire to go outside for higher education. Apart from this, the people from the forest villages despite of having to understanding about importance of the girl's education but hesitate to send their girls outside from the community. All the above perspectives leave bad impact on mind and lead to loss in the morals of girls. These conditions also prevail in our project village which have been covered previously or being covered presently.

Best of our knowledge, these are two operational hostels in Naugarh block but located far away from reach of forest villagers. One hostel is being operated by Vishwa Hindu Parishad as "Maharshi Balmiki Sewa Sansthan" while another is arranged by Uttar Pradesh government as "Kasturba Gandhi Avasiya Balika Vidyalay Residential School". The "Balmiki Sewa Sansthan" is only available for boy's students while "Kasturba Residential School" is open for all resident of the Naugarh block and overcrowded. It is notice that both of the hostels are not able to fulfil the boarding and lodging needs of the girls of forest village. Keep in view the above conditions, VARUN has decided to establish a hostel at Naugarh block headquarter with support of "ASHA for Education"

STATE OF THE ART:

There a hostel has been constructed with support from "ASHA for Education" at Naugarh

block headquarters. This hostel will provide accommodation only for 40 girls students

belonging to SC/ST community residing in forest villages. There is an urgent need to make

it operational. There minimum cost shall be required to make it shooth functioning. The

hostellers shall be kept free of cost in order to help the students for getting higher education

as well as achieve their dreams in due course of time.

OBJECTIVES:

1. To facilitate girls of deprived families residing in the remotely located forest villages

having poor communicability but have desire to higher education.

2. To provide homely environment in the hostel for all round personality development of

the residents.

3. To make the hosteller efficient in the house keeping, cooking and personal hygiene.

4. To arrange remedial classes in the hostel to make them capable to compete with other

students of the class and above all.

5. To bring desirable change in the attitude of villagers regarding higher education of their

offspring preferably the girls.

DURATION: It is planned to continue the hostel till achieving more goal in higher education by

the girls of SC/ST families of the forest villages. Preferences shall be given to the girls of

those villages covered under project till now while selecting girls for the hostel.

COVERAGE OF THE HOSTEL: This hostel will cover about 2500 SC/ST families of more than

40 forest villages of Chandauli and Sonebhadra districts. Some other talented girls from

OBCs families may also be considered for the hostel.
