Background about REWARD:

REWARD trust is run by a group of scientists at the IGCAR, Kalpakkam in Tamilnadu, with the aim of increasing the quality of education of the children in the nearby govt schools by upgrading them to the next level. Their goals are to improve the teacher student ratio and also to increase the graduation rates and the performance of the students in the government schools that they are currently supporting. They work in close association with the local Parent- teacher association (PTA) in appointing the teachers and in paying their salaries till the government officially appoints a teacher by itself. They train the PTA appointed teachers using the resources available like the use of teaching aids etc. Currently, through the funding provided by Asha for education and local funding, they are supporting the salaries of around 65 teachers.

Funding situation:

Asha Uflorida started funding Reward in the year 2014-2015, supporting 7 teachers distributed across the primary, middle school, high school levels in the villages to the south of Palar river. We disbursed INR 6.37 lakh in 2 disbursements, the second disbursement in Feb 2015.

For the calendar year 2015-2016, Mr. Sridhar had requested us to fund 3 additional teachers (1 middle school+2 higher secondary school) apart form the 7 teachers we supported in the previous year. Please see the budget breakdown below. Reward trust has modified the salary ranges of the teachers, <u>fixing the base salary</u> and giving increments based on the performance of the teacher in the SMART tests and student performance in the annual examinations. And the money for the increments comes from the local funding agencies.
