
A Project proposal for Mukti institute of technology (2023-24)





Background

☐ About 18% of the total population of India are within 18 to 25 years (highest in the world) and facing severe challenges due to educated unemployment. One most important factor is lack of job opportunities due to skill gap. Latest report show skilled and knowledgeable human resources being only 48% of the total educated youth in the country! ☐ Paired with hybrid work culture in the era of digital age the demand of skilled youth is on steady growth in sync with the estimate of IMF about 65% of global GDP to be digitised in 2022! □ Joblessness among rural youth (15 to 28 years) has reached its highest level since 1993-94. In 2021, the estimated youth unemployment rate in India was 28.26 percent, according to ILO estimates. The employment opportunities in Sundarbans is quite alarming, as it is one of the most neglected areas in the state and is suffering from disastrous environmental effects.

Educated but unemployed is a serious problem in Sundarbans, as it....

- ☐ Leads to the wastage of capable human resources on whom a lot of other resources have been spent.
- ☐ Can lead to youth engaging in other unlawful activities.
- ☐ May lead to economic, socio-political disturbances.
- □ Sundarbans faces significant economic and social challenges, with high youth unemployment among people who are capable of holding a job. They face challenges such as poverty, marginalization, and an acute struggle against geoclimatic events.
- As an organization, we are committed to bridging the skills gap by providing market-based skill development training to the youths. Our goal is to create more job opportunities for youth, who are among the most vulnerable members of society.

PROPOSED SOLUTION

To address the employment challenge and limited access to the quality training MUKTI has established an institute called the **Mukti Institute of Technology(MIT)** in Kumrapara (Raidighi) with sole objective to up-skill local youth and provide them placement support.

- [A team consisting of Project Coordinator, Vocational Trainer, Training & Placement Coordinator(TPC)(to be hired), Placement Assistant assigned to look after the implementation of the programme. Programme Manager and Education Director will be monitoring the progress of the project on time-to-time basis.]

SAMPLE SURVEY

According to a sample survey conducted in 2016 in the villages of Nagendrapur and Kankandighi in South 24 Parganas, it was found that there were around 7,000 educated unemployed youths in the region. In response to this issue, Mukti established the Mukti Institute of Technology (MIT) in Raidighi and Nagendrapur village to provide professional computer skills training to these youths. In September 2018, following a quality audit, MIT received ISO:9001:2015 certification. The centres offer two sets of ISO-certified courses one free and one paid. The free set focuses on MS Word, MS Excel, email, and internet usage, while the paid set includes courses on account management, desktop office application, web service assistance, desktop management operation, spoken English, and electrical technician skills.

- ☐ To provide employment assistance to the enrolled job seekers through in house initiative as well as through collaboration




PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- ☐ Till now, Mukti has helped 1300+ students to get trained under MIT.
- ☐ Mukti successfully conducted examination at Raidighi Centre for the 2022-23 batch, covering both practical and theoretical topics.
- ☐ A total of 105 examinees appeared for the exam, which covered the fundamentals of computers, Windows OS, and MS Word and felicitated successful students.
- ☐ Out of 167 students, 50% got placements, with 35% of them being male and 15% being female.
- ☐ The students are very happy with the opportunity provided by Mukti. Most of them come from underprivileged families and are the sole breadwinners, so this training and job opportunity has helped them support their families.

Collaborations

With Dreamline Job School

Mukti planned for collaborating with Dreamline Consultancy. As per planning MIT will provide a list of students, Dreamline will select 100 students from this list, and they will support them with job training classes. These students include students from earlier batches, local colleges, local students who are still unemployed and seeking job opportunities. They have demanded 90% attendance for those classes. Each batch will consists 10 students. First class will take place at MIT, where the trainers from Kolkata will visit and take 2 days class, followed by online and offline remaining classes. Final list to be prepared through mock interview. Each student needs to pay Rs. 500 for the registration of the training, rest of the expenses will be paid by students later and Mukti on sharing basis. However, some caution money will be taken from them so that candidates attend the classes regularly. The expenses for Mukti has been given in the budget. The enrolled students will get opportunities for 5 job interviews.

We are proposing a full time Training and Placement coordinator and Placement assistant for employment exchange activities that includes, creating database, interacting and student selection, interviewing for external classes

- ☐ We are planning for in house soft skill training programme for MEE enrolled students.




