


- Promote and sponsor activities to improve education, heighten social and environmental awareness and foster community development.











Organizational Structure

Village Library






- Mr Shudhir Mallick, Senior Manager, TCS inaugurated the Public library on August 15, 2008

○ Vocational Institute and ITI college




- Vocational Training Institute will open shortly in Sunderban

- The teachers also provide special coaching to Madhyamik and HS students.












Flood Relief Program

Current Situation of Sunderban

 More than one lakh small mud houses completely damaged by Aila





• Students from most of the affected families have lost their all educational materials.

Current Situation of Sunderban

• It is very difficult for those student to continue their study now.





• Need urgent help to these students with educational materials.

Concept of the program

- Mukti is planning to provide educational materials to Aila affected students who have lost their everything in Aila and most of them are now staying in relief centres and can not continue their study without outside help.
- Books, white paper, pen, School bag etc will be provided to victim students.
- There will be Mukti team with local school teacher to supervise and manage the work.

Targeted benefits

- Students from most affected Aila area will be benefited and continue their study.
- Many NGOs and Government are taking care of food and other necessity in the region but educational part is mostly unaddressed. Mukti is trying to working in this gap
- This can me a model project to other NGOs and we are trying to involve them also.

MERP details

- Students from Class V- X will be getting books from this program.
- 500 students from every affected GP (Gram Panchayet will be covered)
