RATIOANAL OF THE PROJECT:

In the fight to end global poverty, education is one of the most powerful tools available. But every day, millions of young people are deprived of the higher education when the cost of a college enrollment fee or a hostel and other educational cost stands between them and a brighter future. Fortunately, the Sponsorship Scholarship has helped hundreds of high-achieving students pursue the higher education, graduation education or vocational training they need to build a more stable future. Upon graduation, most are able to support themselves and their families, as well as pay for their siblings' educations. But each year, the number of needy and poor students who qualify for higher education unable to get enrollment in required stream hundreds of hard-working students will be forced to drop out of school. Most will never return. But with your help, we can keep the Sponsorship Scholarship program – and the aspirations of its students – alive.

BARRIERS TO HIGHER & QUALITY EDUCATION

Though Tribal and remote/interior area are on opposite sides of the globe, higher educational access is a challenge for children.

Because learning opportunities are closely tied to income, endemic poverty keeps far too many students from getting the higher education they need to break the cycle of poverty. In tribal area, economic growth has been thriving in recent years, but so too has inequality. The province of tribal and rural people is one of the regions being left behind, with more than 90% families now living below the poverty line. The tribal and remote area, chronic deprivation is even more pervasive, and most of the children grows up in poverty. Earning just a few rupees per year, many parents in the project area struggle to afford basic school fees and materials for their children. When students reach secondary school or higher secondary, the cost becomes prohibitive: Suddenly, enrollment fees are no longer subsidized. Bus fares must also be added, as fewer high schools overall mean greater distances to travel to class. At the college /university level, admission fees, tuition fees and hostel fees can reach higher level per year – an inconceivable sum for the families we serve. In light of these conditions, it is no surprise that 45 percent of students in the project area drop out after primary school. Few graduate high school, and only

five percent are able to attend college. Without a foundation in learning, even the smartest, most talented and driven young people are stripped of the chance to fulfill their potential.

SPONSORSHIP SCHOLARSHIPS TRANSFORM LIVES

Each year, the Sponsorship Scholarship Programme helps 6-8 of students in project area achieve the extraordinary. Through the generosity of partners like you, youth are able to continue their studies and reach higher than they ever thought possible. The program identifies promising young people who are at risk of dropping out of after 12th standard due to financial strain. An application process, which includes in-person interviews and home visits, awards highly motivated students with the financial assistance they desperately need. Sponsorship Scholars can use their awards to pay for college fees, tuition fees, books and materials, or the housing and transportation that is often required to attend a higher level institution. With just a modest infusion of funds, sponsorship scholars can lift their families out of poverty. On average, they maintain a good grade, and most are able to transition into well-paying jobs or successfully start their own businesses, becoming breadwinners who elevate the quality of life for their entire families.

PROJECT OBJECTIVE:

The Scholarship aim to provide financial support to meritorious student who are needy and poor of the society.

GOAL:

The project will support the cost of higher education after 12th grade passed qualified children. Whose parents are subsistence farmers or working on daily wage labours. Their educations will enable them to gain productive employment in the education of future generations of children and at the same time enable them to increase their response to the educational needs of very under-served rural communities. They will also serve as role models and leaders within their rural communities.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project will provide scholarships for higher education who have completed and passed 12th standard. Due to poor economic condition these scholarships are the only source of funds these children will have to enable them to further their studies.

GVT, offers scholarship to support financially underprivileged children. Under the 'Scholarship Programme' meritorious students who face financial problems in continuing their education, can get financial assistance for higher education such as ITI/Diploma/Graduation/Engineering/Medical studies.

METHODOLOGY:

- Scholarship is open for students who have passed 9th standard onward.
- Applicants must have scored at least 60% marks in Class 10 and Class 12.
- The student who selected under scholarship will support to complete their education.
- The student who selected have to score minimum 1st class rank in their yearly exam to get next year scholarship. (Re-Qualify)
- Applicants must be enrolled in a Diploma/ITI/Polytechnic/Graduation/Medical course at a recognized institution in India.
- Family income must be less than or equal to INR 4,00,000 – 5,00,000 (4 -5 Lakhs) per year priority given to BPL Families.
- The student who has been selected under scholarship programme need to spent at least one week time in GVT or Other NGO for community engagement programme.
- The children who have single parents or without parent will give priority for selection.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process of Scholarship is a multi-stage process where scholars will be selected after the assessment of the merit and financial needs of the applicants. The key steps of the selection process are mentioned below:

- Screening of scholarship applications based on merit and financial need.
- Door to door visit by GVT representative to cross check the need of applicants.
- Telephonic interview for further shortlisting of candidates.
- Face to face interview for final selection.

EXPECTED OUTCOME

Educating children changes everything. When a child in project area receives an education, He/she marries later and has fewer children. When He/she earns an income, He/she reinvests it in her family, improving her children's health, education and wellbeing, and He/she contributes to the development of her community and nation. When we invest in child we all win! We empower the next generation to reach their potential as leaders committed to the growth and development of their countries.

LONG TERM IMPACT

- Intelligent Students will get a support to continue their education.
- Child Labor will be discouraged in the communities.
- Literacy rate will be increased among the communities.
- Other students will also be encouraged to get selected for the scholarships.
- Improvement in the socio-economic status of the families.
