 - Ladli (Nursery) and Learning Center (KG-IV); formal education schools
- "Current" Initiatives
 - Initial Initiatives + 6 computer centers in nearby villages + a remedial center
 - Jai Hind Camp (2009), Bal Shiksha (2011)
 - Kanya Vidyalaya (Noida) (upto class X)— for english and computer literacy
- Our Involvement
 - AfE funding this project since 2006, SV started funding in 2009
 - 2010-11 funding: \$21900 (~Rs. 9,70,000)
- Model
 - Families move to find work
 - Transitioning interrupts the education of children
 - Kids lose a year or two
 - Children who start schooling at an older age are put through an accelerated learning program to bring them up to their age level

SShrishti: Background [2]

- Primary schooling
- Computer education
- Special classes for spoken English
- Basic healthcare
- A glass of milk in the morning and a nutritious mid day meal
- Classes for music, dance, art and theatre
- Excursions and outings for entertainment
- Opportunities for sports and games
- Free books, stationery, uniform and toys
- Sshrishti offers **remedial classes in the afternoon** for its weaker students, those studying in government schools and for those students of Sshrishti who have been successfully bridged into other schools.

Activity classes help kids to prepare for Sshrishti's Annual day (used as a FR exercise by them).



- 10 drop outs (went back to village), 2 failed (frequently absent)
- Overall attendance 68.27% (118 students)
- This session had regular classes of spoken English for all grades U.K.G IV, taught by our foreign volunteers.
- During the school summer break the Special English and Computer classes were held. 85 children from the community enrolled for both the subjects.
 The response was very good.
- Students performed on annual day.
- The teachers' retention is better than last year.




