

Project: SShrishti Learning Centre

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My visit to Sshrishti was again a surprise visit ,like last time.This time I had better idea about the location ,so I reached without informing.I reached there at about 11 am.When I entered I met an assistant teacher who then went and called Ms. Roopali Singh.

Mrs. Roopali was at the terrace getting the water tank repaired.

As my last visit,she showed me all the classrooms and introduced me to all the teachers.As I entered, the first class was class 1.It had a very good attendance.30 out of 31 students were present which was quite impressive.Ms Pooja was the class teacher and Ms Neha volunteered to assist her.Kids were happily enjoying their studies.Then was Class 3 which had 18 students out of which 11 were present.Ms Nisha was taking the class and she was very well taking care of the kids.The strength was better than last year and I was told that all new teachers have been appointed this year.We went out in the backyard where lunch was being cooked for the kids(they are provided their lunch at Sshrishti only).It was porridge being cooked with milk and jaggery.Then we went to Class 2.Kids were very well behaved and interactive.Ms. Neelima was the class teacher.15 out of 20 kids were present, who introduced themselves as follows:

Kids not only came from the same vicinity i.e. Kishangarh ,but also from Mehrauli which is at 15-20 min.distance.I was told that the syllabus followed was that of NCERT.The books were easy to understand and covered a lot of aspects.The computer room was intact and the basic computer knowledge is provided by the class teacher only.I was also shown some diyas which the kids were decorating for Diwali.

On the terrace was Class 4 .I was told that Sshrishti has classes from Kindergarten to Class 4.Ms. Roopali said that the Kindergarten students were at their other centre,Sshrishti Laadli.The terrace had a lot of open space where kids have their morning assembly and physical education.They are also encouraged to come up with the News of the Day .Kids are assessed on the basis of their performance during weekly tests and report card is given twice a year.I came to know that the kids also performed at the 10th year celebrations of Sshrishti.

Overall a positive experience.It was nice to see most of the kids taking their studies seriously and following discipline in the class.Great effort by Sshrishti!!
