ASHA SAMAJIK VIDHYALAY (ASV) NAGEPUR



- Due to lockdown in whole country in the month of April, teachers helped in distribution and packaging of ration to impacted families in Covid-19 Relief work.
- In Covid-19, All teachers have helped in packaging of ration as well as made mark sheet of respective classes.
- All classrooms were decorated with syllabus wise educational posters & social Message posters by teachers while maintaining the social distancing.
- In covid-19, dry rations were distributed to the students of financially affected families.
- 70 new students were admitted in New Session.
- Two Hundred Twenty Six Students were called serial wise to give them educational materials like pencil, ruler, eraser; Copy etc & sanitizer, masks by maintain social distancing.

• Form the month of July; twenty students whose parents have

permitted were called for study.





- On coming school, students were sanitized and washed their hands before sitting in the classroom & told them to wear mask every time.
- The Independence Day was celebrated in school by maintaining social distancing and masks & Sweets (Jalebis) were distributed between them.
- 3 New Classrooms Construction work is going on at ASV school.



KISHORI SEWING & VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER



- From the month of July, all embroidery centers were opened with hand wash, sanitizer & masks While Keeping Covid 19 Impact in mind
- Nine Sewing centers were doing the work of making masks.
 Training of two days for making mask was given to teachers.
- Dry ration as well as Hand Wash, Mask, Sanitizer, Sanitary Pad were distributed to the impacted Two Hundred Forty Two



- From the month of September through Kishori sewing center approximately 10,000 masks were made ready.

SELF HELP GROUP (SHG)



- Asha Trust and Lok Samiti is working work with women in the 54
 Village of Arazi Line and Sewapuri block on their issues.
- Due to lockdown (Covid-19) from the month of April in whole country Following work was done with the help of village and Group committee -
 - 1. Ration was distributed among 4000 Families from Group community, widow, disable, helpless & poor.
 - 2. In Group Community, due to Covid-19 Awareness programs were run as well as hand wash, sanitizer & mask was also distributed.
 - 3. One Day workshop was done with the help of Group committee's sister for women Rights & their income.
 - 4. 19 New SHG Groups were introduced keeping social distancing

- 3. To Provide the employment at local level around 1500 migrant workers & 3000 daily wages workers have been surveyed & were also distributed mask also
- In Covid-19, tribute was given to home coming martyr labors.

 Youngsters have also contributed their enough support during Corona Rahat Abhiyaan.
