## Our journey

The Sri Ram Goburdhun Charitable Trust addressed the "WHY's" of the community under its flagship program Project WHY.

We began in 2000 with just 40 students wanting to learn spoken English. Till before the lockdown, we reached 1100 underpriviledged children per year. We trained 2000 women and created 50 job opportunities for people from the community.

#### CENTRE PROGRESS 2022-2023


- Hired English teacher for senior secondary class
- 40% students motivated to participate in different competition in their school
- 30 students won medals, certificates and prizes in competition and also being selected for participating at zonal level
- 5 students sat for the CUET- entrance exams for universities and 1 got selected
- 50% parents involved in PTM after making them aware of their role in the education of their children




#### **OVERALL PROGRESS 2022-2023**

- The Vahani Foundation visited our centres and explained their program in which they sponsor college education for children getting above 80%
- We Organized a series of workshops aimed at giving teachers new tools to deal with new challenges faced post the pandemic with Dr. Neena Gulabani
- A new stitching unit for ladies opened in Govindpuri on May 2022
- 22 women completed 6 months stitching course and were given certificates.
