Hi all,

Our current Kolkata-based project Institute of Social Work's (ISW) has submitted its third annual proposal to us.

Through Asha SF funding, ISW runs a school in Barasat district that supports ~300 underprivileged children by providing formal education (using govt-syllabi) to them from classes Nursery through 7th grade. After that, the children join nearby government schools and are better prepared to face the enormous challenged posed by such schools.

The proposal amount is INR 4,65,000 (~\$8k). This is meant for:

- Operational costs INR 3.51,000
- Infrastructural costs Rs 1,14,000 (purchase of 8 ceiling fans and 60 benches)

**** FYI - Asha SF funded them last cycle for not just operational costs, but also for the construction of first floor of a new school building (ground floor was funded by some other donor). The construction is nearing completion, and the project has asked for one-time costs for purchase of ceiling fans and benches.

Previous cycle's funding was approved for an amount of INR 6,00,000 total (Rs 3,00,000 operational and Rs 3,00,000 construction of new building)
