### Trivia on Barasat School

- Two buildings, one primary and another secondary (upto 8<sup>th</sup> standard)
- The students are eventually sent to the local government schools for higher education
- Currently have 120 male and 130 female students ages 3-14
- 9 teachers and 2 staffs run the school. They have a minimum education level of class 12.
- They also run after-school coaching for students who need special attention.
- Currently all students are placed in class according to their merit and not age. Some retarded children go to lower classes.
- They have a good student teacher relationships. Students like to come to the school. On most days the attendance is almost 100%
