The school has improved in the last year because we have observed the involvement of parents with our school. The students who has left the school, their parents also coming to take advice from the teachers for their children and they are also participate in any programme organized by school and the students also very much associated with the school programmes as and when it organized. \_\_\_\_\_

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**What are the problems you have faced in the last year?** \_\_\_\_\_

Last year Govt. has announced that they will admit all students without any admission test at any class, only they will consider the age and Govt. will not considered any students to admit at upper classes who are coming from non affiliated schools. As a result most of the students left our school without judging their capacity. They could get admission only by their age. We apprehend they will face a problem to follow the syllabus of the specific classes because most of them are not upto the standard to follow the syllabus. It is expected a group of students may be drop out from school when they will not able to follow the school curriculum. \_\_\_\_\_

We have applied for affiliation with all our requisite papers and it was inspected by Education Department of Govt. of West Bengal. After inspection everything was OK but their only demand is to allot the school building and land in the name of school. We could not allow that. Because once we will donate lands and building for the school, we will not be able to use the building for our any work. \_\_\_\_\_
