Our current Kolkata-based project Institute of Social Work's (ISW) has submitted its second annual proposal to us.

Through Asha SF funding, ISW runs a school that supports ~300 underprivileged children by providing formal education (using govt-syllabi) to them from classes Nursery through 7th grade. After that, the children join nearby government schools and are better prepared to face the enormous challenges posed by such schools.

The proposal amount is INR 6,00,000 (~\$10k). This is meant for:

1. Operational costs (INR 3,00,000, 50% of funds asked)
2. Construction of the first floor of their proposed new premises for the children (INR 3,00,000 50% of funds asked).
 - The ground floor is already completed through private funding that ISW separately received. They need a new building for their children due to their previous building no longer being a safe and comfortable infrastructure for the children.

Previous cycle's funding was approved for an amount of INR 1,90,000 for operational costs.
